

COMMITTEE REPORT

MADAM PRESIDENT:

The Senate Committee on Appropriations, to which was referred House Bill No. 1092, has had the same under consideration and begs leave to report the same back to the Senate with the recommendation that said bill be AMENDED as follows:

1 Page 2, delete line 10, begin a new paragraph and insert:
2 "(c) Notwithstanding IC 33-38-5, the part of the total salary and
3 benefits that would otherwise be paid by the state for the judge of
4 the new Johnson superior court No. 4 may not be paid by the
5 auditor of state until the auditor of state receives a resolution of the
6 board of county commissioners of Johnson County that sets forth
7 the board's determination that a building in existence on January
8 1, 2012, has been rehabilitated and is ready as a place for the court
9 added by section 3 of this chapter to hold sessions."
