DIGEST OF HB 1170 (Updated March 25, 2013 3:59 pm - DI 44)

**Citations Affected:** IC 5-28.

**Synopsis:** Training 2000 program. Expands training assistance under the training 2000 program to provide assistance to: (1) new or expanding businesses for the training or retraining of incumbent employees; and (2) any business in Indiana for the retraining and upgrading of employee skills required to support existing capital investment. (Current law restricts training assistance under the training 2000 program to potential employees of new or expanding business and to the retraining and upgrading of skills required to support new capital investment.)

**Effective:** July 1, 2013.

## ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL No. 1170

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A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning state and local administration.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:*

- 1 SECTION 1. IC 5-28-7-2, AS ADDED BY P.L.4-2005, SECTION  
2 34, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1,  
3 2013]: Sec. 2. The corporation shall do the following:  
4 (1) Establish policies to carry out a training assistance program,  
5 the purpose of which is to provide assistance to the following:  
6 (A) New or expanding businesses, for the training **or**  
7 **retraining** of potential **or incumbent** employees and the  
8 retraining and upgrading of the skills of potential **or**  
9 **incumbent** employees.  
10 (B) Businesses in Indiana, for the retraining and upgrading of  
11 employees' skills required to support new **or existing** capital  
12 investment.  
13 (C) Businesses in Indiana, for the development of basic  
14 workforce skills of employees, including the following:  
15 (i) Literacy.  
16 (ii) Communication skills.  
17 (iii) Computational skills.

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- 1 (iv) Other transferable workforce skills approved by the
- 2 corporation.
- 3 (2) Provide promotional materials regarding the training program.
- 4 (3) Determine the eligibility of an industry for the training
- 5 program.
- 6 (4) Require a commitment by a business receiving training
- 7 assistance under this chapter to continue operations at a site on
- 8 which the training assistance is used for at least five (5) years
- 9 after the date the training assistance expires. If a business fails to
- 10 comply with this commitment, the corporation shall require the
- 11 business to repay the training assistance provided to the business
- 12 under this chapter.
