ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL No. 1215

DIGEST OF HB 1215 (Updated March 12, 2013 11:29 am - DI 71)

Citations Affected: IC 36-8.

Synopsis: Fire protection districts. Allows a fire protection district to purchase (with the approval of the county council) firefighting apparatus and equipment for the district on an installment conditional sale or mortgage contract running for a period not exceeding 15 years. (Under current law, the 15 year duration for such a contract applies only to a fire protection district with assessed value of \$60,000,000 or less.)

Effective: July 1, 2013.

ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL No. 1215

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning local government.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

- 1 SECTION 1. IC 36-8-11-26 IS AMENDED TO READ AS

6 purchase the firefighting apparatus and equipment for the district on an
7 installment conditional sale or mortgage contract running for a period
