IMPACT: State & Local

Summary of Legislation: (Amended) This bill requires a court to order a person convicted of the offense of: (1) striking, tormenting, injuring, or otherwise mistreating a law enforcement animal; or (2) interfering with the actions of a law enforcement animal while the animal is engaged in assisting a law enforcement officer; to make restitution to the person or law enforcement agency that owns the animal for reimbursement of replacement costs of the animal if the animal is permanently disabled or killed.

Effective Date: July 1, 2013.

Explanation of State Expenditures: The bill could result in a greater likelihood that the state would be reimbursed for the replacement cost of the enforcement animal. The cost of a trained police dog is between \$8,000 and \$10,000.

Explanation of State Revenues:
