Summary of Legislation: The bill provides that the following persons are exempt from paying fees in addition to application fees to obtain a lifetime unlimited license to carry a handgun in Indiana: (1) A person who is a resident of Indiana and possesses a valid permit to carry a concealed firearm issued by the state of Utah under the Utah law in effect on July 1, 2013. (2) A person who is a resident of Indiana and has successfully completed a course of instruction conducted by a national, state, or local firearms training organization approved by the Utah Bureau of Criminal Identification under the Utah law concerning permits to carry concealed firearms in effect on July 1, 2013.

Effective Date: July 1, 2013.

Explanation of State Expenditures:

Explanation of State Revenues: Summary: There would likely be a minimal reduction revenue collected from lifetime handgun licensing fees, as a result of this bill. It is not likely there are many persons either residing in Indiana with a valid Utah license or have completed a firearms course of instruction recognized by the Utah Bureau of Criminal Identification.

Background Information: The state received \$4.4 M in revenue from handgun carry license fees during FY 2012.
