**Summary of Legislation:** This bill exempts intrastate motor carriers from federal regulations requiring commercial motor vehicles to be equipped with electronic on-board recording devices.

**Effective Date:** July 1, 2013.

**Explanation of State Expenditures:**

*Background:* The 2012 federal highway reauthorization bill, known as *Moving Ahead for Progress in the 21<sup>st</sup> Century Act* or *MAP-21*, requires that all commercial motor vehicles involved in interstate commerce and operated by a driver subject to federal hours-of-service and record-of-duty-status requirements be equipped with an electronic on-board recording device. These regulations are to go into effect within one year of the passage of the legislation, presumably in the second half of 2013.
