Summary of Legislation: This bill requires the county auditor to transfer fees semiannually (instead of monthly) to the Treasurer of State for deposit in the State Sex and Violent Offender Administration Fund.

Explanation of Local Expenditures: Changing this requirement to a semiannual transfer would likely reduce administrative burdens for clerks without fully automated accounting systems. In CY 2011, 33 counties reported transferring fees from the Sex and Violent Offender Registration Fee and the Sex and Violent Offender Address Change Fee to the State Sex and Violent Offender Administration Fund.
