MR. SPEAKER:

I move that Engrossed Senate Bill 1 be amended to read as follows:

- 1 Page 2, delete lines 18 through 42, begin a new paragraph and
2 insert:
3 "SECTION 2. [EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE] (a) As used in this
4 SECTION, "designated school protection officer" means a school
5 employee who is not required to receive law enforcement training
6 at a police academy and is authorized to carry a weapon on school
7 property for the purpose of providing school protection.
8 (b) The legislative council shall assign to the criminal law and
9 sentencing policy study committee established by IC 2-5-33.4-1, for
10 study during the 2013 legislative interim, the topic of school
11 resource officer and designated school protection officer programs.
12 (c) If the topic described in subsection (b) is assigned to an
13 interim or statutory study committee under subsection (b), the
14 study committee shall:
15 (1) study the appropriate responsibilities and duties of a
16 school resource officer;
17 (2) study whether school resource programs should be
18 expanded in Indiana;
19 (3) study how other states use and fund school resource
20 programs;
21 (4) study how to implement the most effective training for
22 school resource officers;
23 (5) study the best practices for school resource officers;
24 (6) study issues relating to the issuance of matching grants by

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the state to assist a school to employ or train a school resource officer or designated school protection officer;

(7) study issues related to designated school protection officers, including:

(A) who determines the appropriate type and amount of training that a designated school protection officer should receive;

(B) issues relating to initial and annual training requirements for a designated school protection officer; and

(C) issues relating to indemnification of schools by the state against a loss resulting from an injury to a person caused by a designated school protection officer; and

(8) any other issue the legislative council determines is appropriate.

(d) The criminal law and sentencing policy study committee shall issue a final report to the legislative council containing the criminal law and sentencing policy study committee's findings and recommendations, including any recommended legislation concerning the topic, not later than November 1, 2013.

(e) This SECTION expires December 31, 2013."
