MR. SPEAKER:

I move that Engrossed Senate Bill 402 be amended to read as follows:

- 1 Page 1, between lines 2 and 3, begin a new paragraph and insert:
- 2 "SECTION 2. IC 20-20-2.5 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
- 3 AS A NEW CHAPTER TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
- 4 JULY 1, 2013]:
- 5 **Chapter 2.5. Principal Leadership Grant Program**
- 6 **Sec. 1. The principal leadership grant program is established to**
- 7 **achieve excellence in teacher and student performance by**
- 8 **strengthening leadership and management skills of practicing**
- 9 **Indiana public school principals.**
- 10 **Sec. 2. (a) The state board, in consultation with the department,**
- 11 **shall adopt rules under IC 4-22-2 that establish:**
- 12 **(1) requirements that public school principals must meet to be**
- 13 **eligible to receive a grant from the principal leadership grant**
- 14 **fund established by section 3 of this chapter to pay for**
- 15 **training at a postsecondary educational institution;**
- 16 **(2) criteria or curriculum requirements for courses and**
- 17 **programs that are offered by a postsecondary educational**
- 18 **institution and that may be paid for with a grant provided**
- 19 **under this chapter;**
- 20 **(3) a requirement that a course or program described in**
- 21 **subdivision (2) contain a mentoring component; and**
- 22 **(4) metrics and an accountability system to determine the**
- 23 **effectiveness of a course or program described in subdivision**
- 24 **(2).**

1 **(b) A program or course at a postsecondary educational**
 2 **institution that a public school principal pays for with a grant**
 3 **received under this chapter must teach the following:**

4 **(1) How to develop the leadership skills and management**
 5 **techniques necessary for providing quality education in**
 6 **Indiana schools.**

7 **(2) How to improve teacher and student performance.**

8 **(3) How to strengthen communication and leadership skills**
 9 **required for the establishment of a broad based support for**
 10 **public education.**

11 **(4) Management skills for use in improving curriculum and**
 12 **instruction.**

13 **(5) How to improve the school environment.**

14 **(c) The department may award grants under this chapter to**
 15 **public school principals who meet the eligibility requirements**
 16 **established by the state board under section 2 of this chapter.**

17 **Sec. 3. (a) The principal leadership grant fund is established to**
 18 **provide grants under this chapter.**

19 **(b) The fund shall be administered by the department.**

20 **(c) The fund consists of:**

21 **(1) appropriations made to the fund by the general assembly;**
 22 **and**

23 **(2) grants, gifts, and donations intended for deposit in the**
 24 **fund.**

25 **(d) The treasurer of state shall invest the money in the fund not**
 26 **currently needed to meet the obligations of the fund in the same**
 27 **manner as other public money may be invested. Interest that**
 28 **accrues from these investments shall be deposited in the fund.**

29 **(e) Money appropriated to or otherwise available in the fund**
 30 **that is unexpended at the end of a state fiscal year does not revert**
 31 **to the state general fund but remains available to the department**
 32 **for use under this chapter.**

33 **Sec. 4. To receive a grant under this chapter, a public school**
 34 **principal must meet the eligibility requirements established by the**
 35 **state board under section 2 of this chapter and must submit an**

1 **application to the department on a form prescribed by the**
2 **department."**
