HOUSE MOTION _____

MR. SPEAKER:

I move that House Bill 1591 be amended to read as follows:

- 1 Page 2, between lines 41 and 42, begin a new paragraph and insert:
- 2 "SECTION 2. IC 12-15-2-2.5 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA
- 3 CODE AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS
- 4 [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2013]: **Sec. 2.5. (a) If the office does not or**
- 5 **cannot, before September 1, 2013, file the affidavit with the**
- 6 **governor as provided in IC 12-15-46-4(c), the office shall**
- 7 **implement this section.**
- 8 **(b) Beginning January 1, 2014, and notwithstanding any other**
- 9 **state law, a person described in 42 U.S.C. 1396a(a)(10)(A)(i)(VIII)**
- 10 **is eligible to receive Medicaid assistance.**
- 11 **(c) The office shall take any action necessary to implement this**
- 12 **section."**
- 13 Page 3, between lines 11 and 12, begin a new paragraph and insert:
- 14 "SECTION 3. IC 12-15-2-13, AS AMENDED BY P.L.218-2007,
- 15 SECTION 9, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
- 16 JULY 1, 2013]: Sec. 13. (a) A pregnant woman:
- 17 (1) who is not described in 42 U.S.C. 1396a(a)(10)(A)(i); and
- 18 (2) whose family income does not exceed the income level
- 19 established in subsection (b);
- 20 is eligible to receive Medicaid.
- 21 (b) A pregnant woman described in this section is eligible to receive
- 22 Medicaid, subject to subsections (c) and (d) and 42 U.S.C. 1396a et
- 23 seq., if her family income does not exceed two hundred percent (200%)
- 24 of the federal income poverty level for the same size family.

1 (c) Medicaid made available to a pregnant woman described in this
2 section is limited to medical assistance for services related to
3 pregnancy, including prenatal, delivery, and postpartum services, and
4 to other conditions that may complicate pregnancy.

5 (d) Medicaid is available to a pregnant woman described in this
6 section for the duration of the pregnancy and for the sixty (60) day
7 postpartum period that begins on the last day of the pregnancy, without
8 regard to any change in income of the family of which she is a member
9 during that time.

10 (e) The office may apply a resource standard in determining the
11 eligibility of a pregnant woman described in this section. **This**
12 **subsection expires December 31, 2013."**

13 Page 11, between lines 21 and 22, begin a new paragraph and insert:
14 "SECTION 16. [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2013] **(a) The legislative**
15 **services agency shall prepare legislation for introduction in the**
16 **2014 regular session of the general assembly to make appropriate**
17 **changes in statutes that are affected by this act.**

18 **(b) This SECTION expires December 31, 2014."**

19 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
