MR. SPEAKER:

I move that Engrossed Senate Bill 586 be amended to read as follows:

- 1 Page 6, between lines 3 and 4, begin a new paragraph and insert:
- 2 "SECTION 9. IC 13-27-9 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
- 3 AS A NEW CHAPTER TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
- 4 JULY 1, 2013]:
- 5 **Chapter 9. Energy Efficient Design**
- 6 **Sec. 1. All state public works projects shall be designed,**
- 7 **constructed, operated, and maintained to achieve maximum energy**
- 8 **efficiency to the extent that this goal can be accomplished on a cost**
- 9 **effective basis considering construction and operating costs over**
- 10 **the life cycle of the building or structure.**
- 11 **Sec. 2. (a) The Indiana department of administration shall**
- 12 **develop design standards for all new state buildings and structures**
- 13 **that require the analysis of the cost effectiveness of building with**
- 14 **the goal of achieving energy efficiency.**
- 15 **(b) Energy efficiency may be demonstrated through design that**
- 16 **achieves any of the following:**
- 17 **(1) The silver rating under the Leadership in Energy and**
- 18 **Environmental Design (LEED) rating system.**
- 19 **(2) The two (2) globes rating under the Green Globes rating**
- 20 **system.**
- 21 **(3) The Environmental Protection Agency's Energy Star.**
- 22 **(4) The equivalent of any of the rating systems described in**
- 23 **subdivisions (1) through (3) that is accredited by the**
- 24 **American National Standards Institute.**

1 **Sec. 3. (a) Repair or renovation of all existing state buildings**
2 **and structures shall be designed to achieve maximum energy**
3 **efficiency to the extent that this goal can be accomplished on a cost**
4 **effective basis, considering construction and operating costs over**
5 **the life cycle of the building or structure.**

6 **(b) Energy efficiency may be demonstrated in the same manner**
7 **as provided in section 2(b) of this chapter.**

8 **(c) The cost analysis for the repair or renovation of existing**
9 **buildings and structures must assign value to:**

10 **(1) historic and aesthetic characteristics of the building or**
11 **structure; and**

12 **(2) the use of locally sourced materials.**

13 **Sec. 4. Indiana hardwood lumber shall be considered for use in**
14 **all state public works projects as a local source material, where**
15 **practicable."**

16 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
