# HOUSE MOTION \_\_\_\_\_

MR. SPEAKER:

I move that House Bill 1276 be amended to read as follows:

- 1 Page 2, after line 4, begin a new paragraph and insert:
- 2 "SECTION 2. IC 36-6-6-10, AS AMENDED BY P.L.146-2008,
- 3 SECTION 713, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS
- 4 [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2013]: Sec. 10. (a) This section does not apply
- 5 to the appropriation of money to pay a deputy or an employee of a
- 6 township assessor with assessment duties or to an elected township
- 7 assessor.
- 8 (b) The township legislative body shall fix the:
- 9 (1) salaries;
- 10 (2) wages;
- 11 (3) rates of hourly pay; and
- 12 (4) remuneration other than statutory allowances;
- 13 of all officers and employees of the township.
- 14 (c) Subject to subsection (d), the township legislative body may
- 15 reduce the salary of an elected or appointed official. However, except
- 16 as provided in subsection (h), the official is entitled to a salary that is
- 17 not less than the salary fixed for the first year of the term of office that
- 18 immediately preceded the current term of office.
- 19 (d) Except as provided in subsection (h), the township legislative
- 20 body may not alter the salaries of elected or appointed officers during
- 21 the fiscal year for which they are fixed, but it may add or eliminate any
- 22 other position and change the salary of any other employee, if the
- 23 necessary funds and appropriations are available.
- 24 (e) If a change in the mileage allowance paid to state officers and

1 employees is established by July 1 of any year, that change shall be  
2 included in the compensation fixed for the township executive and  
3 assessor under this section, to take effect January 1 of the next year.  
4 However, the township legislative body may by ordinance provide for  
5 the change in the sum per mile to take effect before January 1 of the  
6 next year.

7 (f) The township legislative body may not reduce the salary of the  
8 township executive without the consent of the township executive  
9 during the term of office of the township executive as set forth in  
10 IC 36-6-4-2.

11 (g) This subsection applies when a township executive dies or  
12 resigns from office. The person filling the vacancy of the township  
13 executive shall receive at least the same salary the previous township  
14 executive received for the remainder of the unexpired term of office of  
15 the township executive (as set forth in IC 36-6-4-2), unless the person  
16 consents to a reduction in salary.

17 (h) In a year in which there is not an election of members to the  
18 township legislative body, the township legislative body may ~~by~~  
19 ~~unanimous~~ vote to reduce the salaries of the members of the township  
20 legislative body by any amount."

21 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
