Citations Affected: IC 20-26.

Synopsis: School employee background checks. Provides that an expanded criminal history check, for purposes of education law, requires a national criminal history background check. Eliminates other types of permissible record searches under current law.

Effective: July 1, 2013.

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HOUSE BILL No. 1160

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning education.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

14 (i) sex offender registries in all fifty (50) states; or

17 (‡) a:

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1 ~~(A)~~ **(1)** national criminal history background check (as defined in
2 IC 10-13-3-12); and
3 ~~(B)~~ **(2)** check of:
4 ~~(i)~~ **(A)** sex offender registries in all fifty (50) states; or
5 ~~(ii)~~ **(B)** the national sex offender registry maintained by the
6 United States Department of Justice.
