HOUSE BILL No. 1486

DIGEST OF HB 1486 (Updated February 5, 2013 11:07 am - DI 109)

Citations Affected: IC 16-18; IC 16-31.

Synopsis: Military trained emergency medical providers. Provides that the emergency medical services commission (commission) shall issue a license or certificate to a military service applicant who meets certain requirements. Allows the commission to issue a temporary practice certificate or provisional license while the military service applicant is satisfying certain requirements as determined by the commission.

Effective: July 1, 2013.

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HOUSE BILL No. 1486

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning health.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 16-18-2-230.5 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA
2 CODE AS A **NEW** SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS
3 [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2013]: **Sec. 230.5. "Military service**
4 **applicant", for purposes of IC 16-31-11, has the meaning set forth**
5 **in IC 16-31-11-1.**

6 SECTION 2. IC 16-31-11 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
7 AS A **NEW** CHAPTER TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
8 JULY 1, 2013]:

9 **Chapter 11. Licensure of Individuals with Military Training**
10 **Sec. 1. As used in this chapter, "military service applicant"**
11 **means an applicant for licensure or certification under this article**
12 **who has performed service as an active member of any of the**
13 **following:**

- 14 (1) **The armed forces of the United States.**
15 (2) **A reserve component of the armed forces of the United**
16 **States.**
17 (3) **The National Guard.**

1 **Sec. 2. (a) Notwithstanding any other provision of this article,**
2 **the commission shall issue a license or certificate to a military**
3 **service applicant to allow the applicant to provide emergency**
4 **medical services in Indiana if, upon application to the commission,**
5 **the applicant satisfies the following conditions:**

6 **(1) Has:**

7 **(A) completed a military program of training;**

8 **(B) been awarded a military occupational specialty; and**

9 **(C) performed in that occupational specialty;**

10 **at a level that is substantially equivalent to or exceeds the**
11 **academic or experience requirements for the license or**
12 **certificate the applicant is seeking from the commission.**

13 **(2) Has engaged in the active practice of the occupation for**
14 **which the applicant is seeking licensure or certification for at**
15 **least two (2) of the five (5) years preceding the date of the**
16 **application under this section.**

17 **(3) Has not committed any act in any jurisdiction that would**
18 **have constituted grounds for refusal, suspension, or**
19 **revocation of a license or certificate to provide emergency**
20 **medical services in Indiana at the time the act was committed.**

21 **(b) The commission shall waive the fee for the applicant's initial**
22 **licensure or certification.**

23 **Sec. 3. (a) All relevant experience of a military service applicant**
24 **in the discharge of the applicant's official duties while performing**
25 **service described in section 1 of this chapter must be credited in**
26 **the calculation of the number of years the applicant has provided**
27 **emergency medical services for purposes of section 2 of this**
28 **chapter.**

29 **(b) In determining if a military service applicant substantially**
30 **meets the academic requirements for a license or certificate issued**
31 **by the commission, the commission shall consider the**
32 **recommendations in the Guide to the Evaluation of Educational**
33 **Experiences in the Armed Services published by the American**
34 **Council on Education or the council's successor organization.**

35 **Sec. 4. A nonresident who is issued a license or certificate under**
36 **this chapter is entitled to the same rights and subject to the same**
37 **obligations as required of a resident who is issued a license or**
38 **certificate by the commission.**

39 **Sec. 5. (a) Notwithstanding any other provision of this article,**
40 **the commission may issue a temporary practice certificate or**
41 **provisional license to a military service applicant while the military**
42 **service applicant is satisfying certain requirements, as determined**



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1 by the commission, for a license or certificate under section 2 of
2 this chapter.
3 (b) The military service applicant may practice under a
4 temporary practice certificate or provisional license issued under
5 subsection (a) until:
6 (1) a license or certification is granted or denied by the
7 commission;
8 (2) the temporary certificate expires; or
9 (3) the military service applicant fails to comply with the
10 terms of the temporary practice certificate or provisional
11 license.
12 Sec. 6. The commission may adopt rules under IC 4-22-2
13 necessary to implement this chapter.
14 Sec. 7. This chapter does not prohibit a military service
15 applicant from proceeding under the licensure or certification
16 requirements established by the commission under the other
17 provisions of this article.
