DIGEST OF HB 1518 (Updated February 11, 2013 12:05 pm - DI 77)

Citations Affected: IC 25-23.

Synopsis: State board of nursing. Allows the Indiana state board of nursing (board) to hire an education compliance officer. Allows the board to use the impaired nurses account to fund the education compliance officer and to carry out any of the duties of the board. Limits the amount that may be paid from the impaired nurses account in a state fiscal year to fund the education compliance officer.

Effective: July 1, 2013.

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HOUSE BILL No. 1518

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning professions and occupations.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

- 1 SECTION 1. IC 25-23-1-21.5 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA
2 CODE AS A **NEW** SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS
3 [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2013]: **Sec. 21.5. The board may hire an**
4 **education compliance officer who reports directly to the director**
5 **of the board to oversee and perform the educational duties**
6 **required under this chapter.**
7 SECTION 2. IC 25-23-1-34, AS AMENDED BY P.L.134-2008,
8 SECTION 33, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
9 JULY 1, 2013]: Sec. 34. (a) The impaired nurses account is established
10 within the state general fund for the ~~purpose~~ **purposes** of providing
11 money for:
12 (1) providing rehabilitation of impaired registered nurses or
13 licensed practical nurses under this article;
14 (2) **funding the education compliance officer provided for**
15 **under section 21.5 of this chapter; and**
16 (3) **carrying out any of the duties of the board.**
17 The account shall be administered by the Indiana professional licensing

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1 agency.
2 (b) Expenses of administering the account shall be paid from money
3 in the account. The account consists of the following:
4 (1) Funds collected for the rehabilitation of impaired registered
5 nurses and impaired licensed practical nurses under sections
6 11(e), 12(d), and 16.1(d) of this chapter.
7 (2) Funds collected under section 31(c)(2) of this chapter.
8 (3) Fines collected from registered nurses or licensed practical
9 nurses under IC 25-1-9-9(a)(6).
10 (c) The treasurer of state shall invest the money in the account not
11 currently needed to meet the obligations of the account in the same
12 manner as other public money may be invested.
13 (d) Money in the account is appropriated to the board for the
14 ~~purpose~~ purposes stated in subsection (a).
15 (e) **The amount paid from the impaired nurses account in a state**
16 **fiscal year for the purposes stated in subsection (a)(2) and (a)(3)**
17 **may not exceed twelve and one-half percent (12.5%) of the average**
18 **yearly revenue of the impaired nurses account for the two (2)**
19 **preceding state fiscal years.**

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COMMITTEE REPORT

Mr. Speaker: Your Committee on Public Health, to which was referred House Bill 1518, has had the same under consideration and begs leave to report the same back to the House with the recommendation that said bill be amended as follows:

Page 1, line 16, delete "covering any other costs incurred by members of the" and insert "**carrying out any of the duties of the board.**".

Page 1, delete line 17.

Page 2, after line 15, begin a new paragraph and insert:

"(e) The amount paid from the impaired nurses account in a state fiscal year for the purposes stated in subsection (a)(2) and (a)(3) may not exceed twelve and one-half percent (12.5%) of the average yearly revenue of the impaired nurses account for the two (2) preceding state fiscal years."

and when so amended that said bill do pass.
