Citations Affected: IC 9-30-15-3.

Synopsis: Open container laws. Conference committee report for Engrossed House Bill 1579. Provides that, for purposes of open container laws, the exemption for a person who is in the passenger compartment of a vehicle used to transport passengers for compensation or the living quarters of a house coach or trailer does not apply to the operator of the vehicle. **(This conference committee report removes provisions concerning the number of hours of community restitution or service that a person convicted of operating a vehicle while intoxicated must perform.)**
