MR. SPEAKER:

*Your Committee on Roads and Transportation, to which was referred House Bill 1481, has had the same under consideration and begs leave to report the same back to the House with the recommendation that said bill **be amended** as follows:*

- 1 Replace the effective dates in SECTIONS 1 through 5 with
- 2 "[EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE]".
- 3 Page 1, line 3, after "49.9." insert "(a)".
- 4 Page 1, between lines 4 and 5, begin a new paragraph and insert:
- 5 "**(b) This section expires on the date IC 9-29-6-0.5 expires.**".
- 6 Page 1, line 7, after "120.7." insert "(a)".
- 7 Page 2, line 4, delete "single axle weight of twenty-nine thousand
- 8 (29,000)" and insert "**maximum wheel weight, unladen or with load,**
- 9 **not to exceed eight hundred (800) pounds per inch of tire,**
- 10 **measured between the flanges of the rim.**
- 11 **(B) A single axle weight not to exceed twenty thousand**
- 12 **(20,000) pounds.**
- 13 **(C) An axle in an axle combination not to exceed twenty**
- 14 **thousand (20,000) pounds per axle, with the exception of**

1 **one (1) tandem group that may weigh twenty-four**
2 **thousand (24,000) pounds per axle or a total of forty-eight**
3 **thousand (48,000) pounds.**

4 **(b) Subsection (a)(5) and this subsection expire on the earlier of**
5 **the following dates:**

6 **(1) The date rules are adopted as required under**
7 **IC 9-29-6-13.**

8 **(2) December 31, 2014.**

9 SECTION 3. IC 9-13-2-187.5 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
10 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE]: Sec. 187.5. **(a)** "Trip",
11 for purposes of IC 9-29-6-1, means the movement of a vehicle or
12 combination of vehicles having a total gross weight greater than eighty
13 thousand (80,000) pounds but less than one hundred thirty-four
14 thousand (134,000) pounds within a twenty-four (24) hour period.

15 **(b) This section expires on the date IC 9-29-6-1 expires."**

16 Page 2, delete lines 5 through 24.

17 Page 2, line 27, delete "(a)".

18 Page 2, line 34, delete "single trip or single route".

19 Page 2, delete lines 36 through 41.

20 Page 3, line 2, after "0.5." insert "**(a)**".

21 Page 3, line 6, delete "TEN" and insert "**ELEVEN**".

22 Page 3, line 31, delete "Determine the result of" and insert
23 "**Subtract three (3) from the STEP NINE amount.**

24 **STEP ELEVEN: Determine the result of:**

25 **(A) the STEP TEN amount; multiplied by**

26 **(B) the number of miles in the trip.**

27 **(b) This section expires on the earlier of the following dates:**

28 **(1) The date rules are adopted as required under section 13 of**
29 **this chapter.**

30 **(2) December 31, 2014."**

31 Page 3, delete lines 32 through 33, begin a new paragraph and
32 insert:

33 "SECTION 6. IC 9-29-6-1 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
34 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE]: Sec. 1. **(a)** A vehicle or
35 combination of vehicles having a total gross weight greater than eighty
36 thousand (80,000) pounds but less than one hundred thirty-four
37 thousand (134,000) pounds must obtain a special weight permit for
38 each trip on an extra heavy duty highway. The fee for this special

1 weight permit is forty-one dollars and fifty cents (\$41.50).

2 **(b) This section expires on the earlier of the following dates:**

3 **(1) The date rules are adopted as required under section 13 of**
4 **this chapter.**

5 **(2) December 31, 2014.**

6 SECTION 7. IC 9-29-6-3, AS AMENDED BY P.L.6-2012,
7 SECTION 71, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
8 UPON PASSAGE]: Sec. 3. (a) The fees for permits issued under
9 IC 9-20-6 to exceed the legal weight limit are as follows:

10 (1) A trip permit, twenty dollars (\$20).

11 (2) A mileage fee, which is in addition to the trip permit fee in
12 subdivision (1), to be calculated for that part of the gross weight
13 exceeding eighty thousand (80,000) pounds as follows:

14 (A) For loads greater than eighty thousand (80,000) pounds
15 but not more than one hundred eight thousand (108,000)
16 pounds, thirty-five cents (\$0.35) per mile.

17 (B) For loads greater than one hundred eight thousand
18 (108,000) pounds but not more than one hundred fifty
19 thousand (150,000) pounds, sixty cents (\$0.60) per mile.

20 (C) For loads greater than one hundred fifty thousand
21 (150,000) pounds, one dollar (\$1) per mile.

22 (3) A ninety (90) day permit, two hundred dollars (\$200).

23 (4) An annual permit issued under IC 9-20-6-2(c), eight hundred
24 dollars (\$800).

25 (b) If an application for a permit involves transporting heavy
26 vehicles or loads, or other objects, that exceed the legal length, width,
27 or height limit and that also exceed the legal weight limit in the same
28 movement, the applicant shall pay only the greater of the two (2) fees
29 established in section 2 or 3 of this chapter and the issuing officer or
30 body shall issue a single oversize-overweight permit. The fee for a
31 ninety (90) day permit described in IC 9-20-6-2(c)(3) is two hundred
32 dollars (\$200).

33 **(c) This section expires of the earlier of the following dates:**

34 **(1) The date rules are adopted as required under section 13 of**

36 **(2) July 1, 2014."**

- 5 Page 4, run in lines 1 through 6.
- 6 Page 4, after line 12, begin a new paragraph and insert:
- 7 "SECTION 9. IC 9-29-6-13 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
- 8 AS A **NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE**
- 9 **UPON PASSAGE]: Sec. 13. (a) The Indiana department of**
- 10 **transportation shall adopt rules under IC 4-22-2 for the:**
- 11 **(1) issuance, fee structure, and enforcement of overweight**
- 12 **divisible loads;**
- 13 **(2) fee structure of loads on extra heavy duty highways; and**
- 14 **(3) fee structure of overweight loads;**
- 15 **not later than December 31, 2014.**
- 16 **(b) The fees outlined in the rules under subsection (a) may not**
- 17 **be increased more often than once every two (2) years.**

- 20 [EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE]: Sec. 26. (a) The superintendent may
- 21 assign qualified persons who are not state police officers to supervise
- 22 or operate permanent or portable weigh stations. A person assigned
- 23 under this section may stop, inspect, and issue citations to operators of
- 24 trucks and trailers having a declared gross weight of at least ten
- 25 thousand one (10,001) pounds and buses at a permanent or portable
- 26 weigh station or while operating a clearly marked Indiana state police
- 27 vehicle for violations of the following:
- 28 (1) IC 6-1.1-7-10.
- 29 (2) IC 6-6-1.1-1202.
- 30 (3) IC 6-6-2.5.
- 31 (4) IC 6-6-4.1-12.
- 32 (5) IC 8-2.1.
- 33 (6) IC 9-18.
