MR. SPEAKER:

*Your Committee on Public Policy, to which was referred Senate Bill 173, has had the same under consideration and begs leave to report the same back to the House with the recommendation that said bill **be amended** as follows:*

- 1 Page 4, line 31, delete "16.1" and insert "**16.2**".
- 2 Page 4, line 32, delete "a" and insert "**not more than six (6) new**".
- 3 Page 4, line 32, delete "permit" and insert "**permits**".
- 4 Page 4, line 34, delete ":".
- 5 Page 4, line 35, delete "(1)".
- 6 Page 4, line 35, delete "; or".
- 7 Page 4, delete line 36.
- 8 Page 4, run in lines 34 through 37.
- 9 Page 4, line 39, after "transferred." insert "**If the commission issues**
- 10 **six (6) new permits under this subsection, and a permit issued**
- 11 **under this subsection is later revoked or is not renewed, the**
- 12 **commission may issue another new permit, as long as the total**
- 13 **number of active permits issued under this subsection does not**
- 14 **exceed six (6) at any time. The commission shall conduct an auction**

1 of the permits under IC 7.1-3-22-9, except that the auction may be
 2 conducted at any time as determined by the commission.
 3 Notwithstanding any other law, the minimum bid for an initial
 4 permit under this subsection is ten thousand dollars (\$10,000).".

5 Page 4, delete lines 40 through 42, begin a new paragraph and
 6 insert:

7 "SECTION 2. IC 7.1-3-20-16.2 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA
 8 CODE AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS
 9 [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2013]: **Sec. 16.2. (a) This section applies to a
 10 municipal lakefront development project authorized under section
 11 16(j) of this chapter.**

12 **(b) In order to qualify for a permit, an applicant must
 13 demonstrate that the municipal lakefront development project area
 14 where the permit is to be located meets the following criteria:**

15 **(1) The municipal lakefront development project area must be
 16 located in a city (as defined in IC 36-1-2-3).**

17 **(2) All of the following must be located within the corporate
 18 boundaries of the city described in subdivision (1):**

19 **(A) A city park.**

20 **(B) A baseball stadium.**

21 **(C) An oil refinery.**

22 **(3) The project boundaries must border on Lake Michigan.**

23 **(4) The proposed permit premises may not be located more
 24 than:**

25 **(A) one thousand five hundred (1,500) feet; or**

26 **(B) three (3) city blocks;**

27 **from Lake Michigan, whichever is greater. However, if the
 28 area adjacent to Lake Michigan is incapable of being
 29 developed because the area is in a floodplain, or for any other
 30 reason that prevents the area from being developed, the
 31 distances described in clauses (A) and (B) are measured from
 32 the city blocks located nearest to Lake Michigan that are
 33 capable of being developed.**

34 **(5) The permit premises are located within:**

35 **(A) an economic development area, a redevelopment
 36 project area, an urban renewal area, or a redevelopment
 37 area established under IC 36-7-14, IC 36-7-14.5, or
 38 IC 36-7-15.1;**

- 1 **(B) an economic development project district under**
- 2 **IC 36-7-15.2 or IC 36-7-26; or**
- 3 **(C) a community revitalization enhancement district**
- 4 **designated under IC 36-7-13-12.1.**
- 5 **(6) The project must be funded in part with state, local, and**
- 6 **federal money.**
- 7 **(7) The boundaries of the municipal lakefront development**
- 8 **project must be designated by ordinance or resolution by the**
- 9 **legislative body (as defined in IC 36-1-2-9) of the city in which**
- 10 **the project is located.**
- 11 **(c) Proof of compliance with subsection (b) must consist of the**
- 12 **following documentation, which is required at the time the permit**
- 13 **application is filed with the commission:**
- 14 **(1) A detailed map showing:**
- 15 **(A) definite boundaries of the entire municipal lakefront**
- 16 **development project; and**
- 17 **(B) the location of the proposed permit within the project.**
- 18 **(2) A copy of the local ordinance or resolution of the local**
- 19 **governing body authorizing the municipal lakefront**
- 20 **development project.**
- 21 **(3) Detailed information concerning the expenditures of state,**
- 22 **local, and federal funds on the municipal lakefront**
- 23 **development project.**
- 24 **(d) A permit may not be issued if the proposed permit premises**
- 25 **is the location of an existing three-way permit subject to**
- 26 **IC 7.1-3-22-3."**
- 27 Delete pages 5 through 7.
