*Your Committee on Employment, Labor and Pensions, to which was referred House Bill 1057, has had the same under consideration and begs leave to report the same back to the House with the recommendation that said bill **be amended** as follows:*

- 1 Page 1, between the enacting clause and line 1, begin a new
- 2 paragraph and insert:
- 3 "SECTION 1. IC 33-39-7-0.1, AS ADDED BY P.L.220-2011,
- 4 SECTION 543, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS
- 5 [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2013]: Sec. 0.1. The amendments made to
- 6 sections 15, 16, and 19 of this chapter by P.L.33-2006 apply to a
- 7 participant in the fund who:
- 8 (1) is serving on July 1, 2006; or
- 9 (2) ~~begins service~~ **serves** after July 1, 2006;
- 10 in a position described in section 8 of this chapter.
- 11 SECTION 2. IC 33-39-7-8 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
- 12 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2013]: Sec. 8. (a) As used in this
- 13 chapter, "services" means the ~~period beginning on the first day upon~~
- 14 **sum of all periods in which a person first became: is employed as:**
- 15 (1) a prosecuting attorney or chief deputy prosecuting attorney;
- 16 (2) any other deputy prosecuting attorney who is:

- 1 (A) appointed under IC 33-39-6-2; and
 2 (B) paid by the state from the state general fund; or
 3 (3) the executive director or the assistant executive director of the
 4 prosecuting attorneys council of Indiana.

5 ~~whether that date is before, on, or after January 1, 1990; and ending on~~
 6 ~~the date under consideration, including all intervening employment in~~
 7 ~~a position described in subdivisions (1) through (3).~~ If an individual is
 8 elected or appointed to a position described in subdivisions (1) through
 9 (3) and serves one (1) or more terms or part of a term, then retires from
 10 office **or otherwise separates from service**, but at a later period or
 11 periods is appointed or elected and serves in a position described in
 12 subdivisions (1) through (3), the individual shall pay into the fund

19 Page 2, between lines 6 and 7, begin a new paragraph and insert:

20 "SECTION 4. IC 33-39-7-13, AS AMENDED BY P.L.16-2011,
 21 SECTION 9, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
 22 JULY 1, 2013]: Sec. 13. (a) A participant who:

23 (1) ceases service in a position described in section 8 of this
 24 chapter, other than by death or disability; and

25 (2) is not eligible for a retirement benefit under this chapter;
 26 is entitled to withdraw from the fund, beginning on the date specified
 27 by the participant in a written application. The date upon which the
 28 withdrawal begins may not be before the date of final termination of
 29 employment or the date thirty (30) days before the receipt of the
 30 application by the board. Upon withdrawal the participant is entitled to
 31 receive the total sum contributed plus interest at a rate specified by rule
 32 by the board, payable not later than sixty (60) days from the date of the
 33 withdrawal application.

34 (b) Notwithstanding section 8 of this chapter, a participant who
 35 withdraws from the fund under subsection (a) and becomes a
 36 participant again at a later date is not entitled to service credit for years
 37 of service before the withdrawal, **unless the participant pays into the**
 38 **fund the full amount received by the participant when the**

2 participant service credit for years of service by the participant
3 before the participant's withdrawal from the fund if the
4 participant makes the repayment required by this subsection in a
5 lump sum or a series of payments determined by the board, not
6 exceeding five (5) annual installments."

8 Page 2, between lines 29 and 30, begin a new line double block
9 indented and insert:

12 service is at least eighty-five (85); or".

13 Page 2, line 30, delete "(B)" and insert "(C)".

14 Page 2, delete lines 34 through 42, begin a new paragraph and
15 insert:

16 "SECTION 6. IC 33-39-7-16, AS AMENDED BY P.L.16-2011,
17 SECTION 11, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
18 JULY 1, 2013]: Sec. 16. (a) This section does not apply to a participant
19 who meets the requirements for disability benefits under becomes
20 permanently disabled, as described in section 17 of this chapter.

21 (b) A participant who:

22 (1) applies for a retirement benefit; and

23 (2) is at least:

24 (A) sixty-five (65) years of age; or

25 (B) fifty-five (55) years of age and the participant's age in
26 years plus the participant's years of service is at least
27 eighty-five (85);

28 is entitled to an annual retirement benefit as calculated in
29 subsection (c).

30 (b) (c) Except as provided in subsections (c) and (d); subsection (e),
31 the amount of the annual retirement benefit to which a participant who
32 applies for a retirement benefit and who is at least sixty-five (65) years

17 **provided by this section upon the death of the participant. A**
18 **participant may designate a trust or a custodian account under**
19 **IC 30-2-8.5 that is established for one (1) or more of the**
20 **participant's surviving dependent children to receive the benefit**
21 **provided by this section instead of designating one (1) or more of**

- 24 **(4)** A child entitled to a benefit shall receive that child's share
