

First Regular Session 118th General Assembly (2013)

PRINTING CODE. Amendments: Whenever an existing statute (or a section of the Indiana Constitution) is being amended, the text of the existing provision will appear in this style type, additions will appear in **this style type**, and deletions will appear in ~~this style type~~.

Additions: Whenever a new statutory provision is being enacted (or a new constitutional provision adopted), the text of the new provision will appear in **this style type**. Also, the word **NEW** will appear in that style type in the introductory clause of each SECTION that adds a new provision to the Indiana Code or the Indiana Constitution.

Conflict reconciliation: Text in a statute in *this style type* or ~~this style type~~ reconciles conflicts between statutes enacted by the 2012 Regular Session of the General Assembly.

HOUSE ENROLLED ACT No. 1295

AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning higher education.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

SECTION 1. IC 21-45-2-2, AS ADDED BY P.L.2-2007, SECTION 286, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2013]: Sec. 2. (a) The Indiana University ~~department~~ **school** of public health shall provide instruction of students in public health problems, personnel, and equipment. The Indiana University ~~department~~ **school** of public health may provide short courses in:

- (1) public health practice for physicians;
- (2) dental health practice for dentists; and
- (3) public health for nurses and all other persons desiring to develop a technical understanding in public health matters.

The courses provided under this section may also be provided for lay groups in phases of public health and sanitary measures appropriate to the occupation or profession of the groups.

(b) The courses provided under this section may be held at any convenient place in Indiana.

(c) The courses provided under this section for nurses must be planned in cooperation with the director of nursing education for Indiana University.
