DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Synopsis: Law enforcement animals in schools. Allows a law enforcement officer to enter a school facility with a bomb or narcotics detecting law enforcement animal so the animal may attempt to detect bombs or narcotics.

SENATE BILL No. 122



A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning education.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 20-33-8-32, AS ADDED BY P.L.1-2005,
2 SECTION 17, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
3 JULY 1, 2013]: Sec. 32. (a) A school corporation must provide each:
4 (1) student; and
5 (2) student's parent;
6 a copy of the rules of the governing body on searches of students'
7 lockers and locker contents.
8 (b) A student who uses a locker that is the property of a school
9 corporation is presumed to have no expectation of privacy in:
10 (1) that locker; or
11 (2) the locker's contents.
12 (c) In accordance with the rules of the governing body, a principal
13 may search:
14 (1) a student's locker; and
15 (2) the locker's contents;
16 at any time.
17 (d) A law enforcement agency having jurisdiction over the



1 geographic area having a school facility containing a student's locker
2 may:
3 (1) at the request of the school principal; and
4 (2) in accordance with rules of the governing body of the school
5 corporation;
6 assist a school administrator in searching a student's locker and the
7 locker's contents.
8 **(e) A law enforcement agency having jurisdiction over the**
9 **geographic area having a school facility may:**
10 **(1) enter the school facility with a bomb or narcotics detecting**
11 **law enforcement animal; and**
12 **(2) allow the animal to attempt to detect bombs or narcotics.**
13 **The law enforcement officer who has control of the law**
14 **enforcement animal shall ensure that the presence of the animal**
15 **does not unduly disrupt the normal operation of the school facility.**
