Synopsis: Supreme court justices and court of appeals judges. Removes a provision that requires justices of the supreme court and judges of the court of appeals to retire at 75 years of age.

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning courts and court officers.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 33-38-13-8 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
2 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2013]: Sec. 8. ~~(a) Every justice of~~
3 ~~the supreme court and judge of the court of appeals shall retire at~~
4 ~~seventy-five (75) years of age.~~

5 ~~(b) Notwithstanding subsection (a),~~ The supreme court may
6 authorize retired justices and judges to perform temporary judicial
7 duties in any state court.
