
SENATE BILL No. 300

DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 7.1-5-7; IC 35-51-7-1.

Synopsis: Alcohol consumption by a minor. Makes it a Class B misdemeanor for a person at least 21 years of age to recklessly, knowingly, or intentionally allow a minor to consume an alcoholic beverage on property owned, leased, or controlled by the person. Makes it a Class B misdemeanor for a person at least 21 years of age to rent a hotel or motel room knowing that the hotel or motel room will be used for the consumption of alcoholic beverages by a minor. Specifies that a judgment for a violation is in addition to any criminal penalty that may be imposed for contributing to the delinquency of a minor. Provides that the criminal provisions regarding selling or furnishing alcoholic beverages to a minor or allowing a minor to consume an alcoholic beverage on the property owned, leased, or controlled by the person does not preclude a tort claim against the person.

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning alcohol and tobacco.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 7.1-5-7-8.5 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
2 AS A **NEW** SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY
3 1, 2013]: **Sec. 8.5. (a) A person at least twenty-one (21) years of age**
4 **who recklessly, knowingly, or intentionally allows a minor to**
5 **consume an alcoholic beverage on property owned, leased, or**
6 **controlled by the person commits a Class B misdemeanor.**

7 (b) A person at least twenty-one (21) years of age who rents a
8 hotel or motel room knowing that the hotel or motel room will be
9 used for the consumption of alcoholic beverages by a minor
10 commits a Class B misdemeanor.

11 (c) A judgment imposed for a violation of this section is in
12 addition to any criminal penalty that may be imposed for
13 contributing to the delinquency of a minor (IC 35-46-1-8).

14 SECTION 2. IC 7.1-5-7-18 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
15 AS A **NEW** SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY
16 1, 2013]: **Sec. 18. This chapter does not preclude a person from**
17 **bringing a tort claim against another person who:**



1 **(1) sells, barter, exchanges, provides, or furnishes an**
 2 **alcoholic beverage to a minor; or**
 3 **(2) allows a minor to consume an alcoholic beverage on**
 4 **property owned, leased, or controlled by the person.**
