DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 12-17.2-3.5-5.5.

Synopsis: Required curriculum for CCDF funding. Specifies requirements related to use of a curriculum as a condition of eligibility for federal Child Care and Development Fund (CCDF) voucher payments. (The introduced version of this bill was prepared by the committee on child care.)

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning human services.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 12-17.2-3.5-5.5, AS AMENDED BY P.L.162-2005,
2 SECTION 2, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
3 JULY 1, 2013]: Sec. 5.5. (a) A provider shall ensure that a child in the
4 provider's care is continually supervised by a caregiver.
5 (b) A provider who operates a child care program in the provider's
6 home (including a child care home licensed under IC 12-17.2-5) and
7 who receives a voucher payment under this chapter shall complete the
8 training course provided or approved by the division under
9 IC 12-17.2-2-1(10) concerning safe sleeping practices.
10 (c) A provider shall:
11 (1) use a curriculum that complies with the department of
12 education's Foundations to the Indiana Academic Standards
13 for Young Children (or successor standards adopted by the
14 department of education); and
15 (2) maintain documentation of:
16 (A) daily implementation of the curriculum with each child
17 in the provider's care; and

(B) training of:
(i) the individual who is responsible for directing the provider's child care program; and
(ii) each supervising caregiver;
concerning the department of education's Foundations to the Indiana Academic Standards for Young Children (or successor standards adopted by the department of education).
