## DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

**Citations Affected:** IC 4-23-24.2-8.

**Synopsis:** Advisory commission on intergovernmental relations. Requires legislative appointments of local government officials to the Indiana advisory commission on intergovernmental relations (commission) to be made from nominees submitted by any legislative member of the commission. Provides that if the legislative members nominate fewer than the number of individuals needed to fill the vacancies, the remaining vacancies shall be filled from nominees submitted by associations representing local government. (Under current law, all appointments are made from nominees of associations representing local government.)

**Effective:** July 1, 2013.

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning state offices and administration.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:*

1 SECTION 1. IC 4-23-24.2-8 IS AMENDED TO READ AS  
2 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2013]: Sec. 8. (a) The following  
3 thirteen (13) individuals are the members of the commission  
4 representing local governments:

5 (1) Four (4) municipal officials, two (2) appointed by the  
6 president pro tempore of the senate and two (2) appointed by the  
7 speaker of the house of representatives from nominees ~~of the~~  
8 **submitted by any legislative member of the commission. If**  
9 **fewer than four (4) individuals are nominated by the**  
10 **legislative members of the commission, any remaining**  
11 **vacancies shall be filled from nominees submitted by the**  
12 **Indiana Association of Cities and Towns. ~~who~~ The members**  
13 **selected under this subdivision** may be selected as follows:

- 14 (A) The mayor of a first class city.
- 15 (B) One (1) member of the legislative body of a second class  
16 city.
- 17 (C) The mayor or a member of the legislative body of a third



- 1 class city.
- 2 (D) The executive of a town.
- 3 (2) Four (4) county officials, two (2) appointed by the president  
4 pro tempore of the senate and two (2) appointed by the speaker of  
5 the house of representatives from nominees ~~of the~~ **submitted by**  
6 **any legislative member of the commission. If fewer than four**  
7 **(4) individuals are nominated by the legislative members of**  
8 **the commission, any remaining vacancies shall be filled from**  
9 **nominees of the** Association of Indiana Counties. One (1)  
10 member appointed under this subdivision may be a member of a  
11 county fiscal body and one (1) member appointed under this  
12 subdivision may be a member of a county executive.
- 13 (3) Two (2) township officials, one (1) appointed by the president  
14 pro tempore of the senate and one (1) appointed by the speaker of  
15 the house of representatives from nominees ~~of the~~ **submitted by**  
16 **any legislative member of the commission. If fewer than two**  
17 **(2) individuals are nominated by the legislative members of**  
18 **the commission, any remaining vacancies shall be filled from**  
19 **nominees of the** Township Trustees Association.
- 20 (4) One (1) person appointed by the governor who represents a  
21 regional or multiple county local governmental entity.
- 22 (5) Two (2) persons, one (1) appointed by the president pro  
23 tempore of the senate and one (1) appointed by the speaker of the  
24 house of representatives, who may have expertise or experience  
25 in intergovernmental relations.
- 26 A member appointed under this section may designate another  
27 individual to serve on the commission for the member.
- 28 (b) A member appointed under this section serves on the  
29 commission until the earliest of the following:
- 30 (1) Two (2) years after the date of the member's appointment.
- 31 (2) The date the member is removed by the member's appointing  
32 authority.
- 33 (3) The date the member no longer holds the office or position the  
34 member held when appointed to the commission.
