

SENATE BILL No. 320

DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: Noncode.

Synopsis: Class basketball public question. Requires a public question to be placed on the ballot at the 2014 general election asking voters whether the Indiana high school basketball tournament should be played under a single class system. Specifies that the vote on the public question is advisory only. Provides that the statute expires July 1, 2015.

Effective: July 1, 2013.

SENATE BILL No. 320



A BILL FOR AN ACT concerning elections.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2013] (a) **The county election**
2 **board of each county shall place the following public question on**
3 **the ballot at the November 2014 general election:**
4 **"Should the Indiana high school basketball tournament be**
5 **played under a single class system?"**
6 (b) **The county election board shall print the following**
7 **immediately below the public question stated in subsection (a):**
8 **"The vote on this question is advisory only. The result of the**
9 **vote on this question is not binding on the General Assembly or the**
10 **governor."**
11 (c) **Each county election board shall:**
12 **(1) tabulate the votes cast on the public question stated in**
13 **subsection (a); and**
14 **(2) certify the results under IC 3-12-4-9.**
15 (d) **IC 3 applies to the public question required by this section**
16 **except where IC 3 conflicts with this section.**
17 (e) **The secretary of state shall certify the results of the vote in**
18 **each county on the public question required by this section to each**



- 1 of the following:
2 (1) The speaker of the house of representatives.
3 (2) The minority leader of the house of representatives.
4 (3) The president pro tempore of the senate.
5 (4) The minority leader of the senate.
6 (5) The governor.
7 (f) This SECTION expires July 1, 2015.
