

# SENATE BILL No. 393

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## DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

**Citations Affected:** IC 8-14-16-5.

**Synopsis:** Training grants from local major moves funds. Provides that the fiscal body of a county, city, or town that has a local major moves construction fund may appropriate money in the fund for educational and work training and retraining programs.

**Effective:** July 1, 2013.

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning transportation.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:*

- 1 SECTION 1. IC 8-14-16-5, AS AMENDED BY P.L.232-2007,
- 2 SECTION 6, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
- 3 JULY 1, 2013]: Sec. 5. Money in the fund may be expended only for
- 4 the following purposes:
- 5 (1) Construction of highways, roads, and bridges.
- 6 (2) In a county that is a member of the northwest Indiana regional
- 7 development authority, or in a city or town located in such a
- 8 county, any purpose for which the regional development authority
- 9 may make expenditures under IC 36-7.5.
- 10 (3) Providing funding for economic development projects (as
- 11 defined in IC 6-3.5-7-13.1(c)(1) or IC 6-3.5-7-13.1(c)(2)(A)
- 12 through IC 6-3.5-7-13.1(c)(2)(K)).
- 13 (4) Matching federal grants for a purpose described in this
- 14 section.
- 15 (5) Providing funding for interlocal agreements under IC 36-1-7
- 16 for a purpose described in this section.
- 17 (6) Providing the county's, city's, or town's contribution to a



1 regional development authority established under IC 36-7.6-2-3.  
2 **(7) Providing funding for:**  
3 **(A) educational programs;**  
4 **(B) work training programs;**  
5 **(C) worker retraining programs; or**  
6 **(D) any other programs;**  
7 **designed to prepare individuals to participate in the**  
8 **competitive and global economy.**

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
