DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 1-1-15; IC 1-1-16.

Synopsis: Recognition of certain days. Designates the fourth Saturday of July as the National Day of the Cowboy and Cowgirl in Indiana. Designates the third weekend of May as the First People's Celebration Weekend in Indiana in observance of the Corn Planting Moon Ceremony.

Effective: Upon passage; July 1, 2013.

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning general provisions.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 1-1-15 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE AS
2 A **NEW** CHAPTER TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY
3 1, 2013]:

4 **Chapter 15. National Day of the Cowboy and Cowgirl**

5 **Sec. 1. The fourth Saturday of July is designated as the**
6 **"National Day of the Cowboy and Cowgirl" in Indiana.**

7 **Sec. 2. All residents of Indiana are encouraged to observe the**
8 **day designated in section 1 of this chapter with appropriate**
9 **ceremonies and activities.**

10 SECTION 2. IC 1-1-16 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE AS
11 A **NEW** CHAPTER TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE UPON
12 PASSAGE]:

13 **Chapter 16. First People's Celebration Weekend**

14 **Sec. 1. The third weekend of May is designated as the "First**
15 **People's Celebration Weekend" in Indiana in observance of the**
16 **Corn Planting Moon Ceremony.**

17 **Sec. 2. All residents of Indiana are encouraged to observe the**



1 **weekend designated in section 1 of this chapter with appropriate**
2 **ceremonies and activities.**

3 **SECTION 3. An emergency is declared for this act.**
