

HOUSE BILL No. 1009

DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 27-16-10-1.

Synopsis: Professional employer organizations. Specifies that a professional employer organization is not a successor employer for purposes of employer contributions to the unemployment compensation system.

Effective: July 1, 2013.

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning insurance.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 27-16-10-1, AS ADDED BY P.L.245-2005,
 2 SECTION 7, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
 3 JULY 1, 2013]: Sec. 1. (a) For purposes of IC 22-4, a covered
 4 employee of a PEO is an employee of the PEO.
 5 (b) A PEO is responsible for the payment of contributions, penalties,
 6 and interest on wages paid by the PEO to the PEO's covered employees
 7 during the term of the professional employer agreement.
 8 (c) **A PEO or PEO group is not, as a result of entering into a**
 9 **co-employment relationship, considered to be a successor employer**
 10 **under IC 22-4-10.**
