
HOUSE BILL No. 1072

DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 8-14-2-4.

Synopsis: Pickup trucks in road funding formula. Provides that the money in the local road and street account shall be distributed among counties according to the ratio of each county's passenger car and pickup truck registrations to the total passenger car and pickup truck registrations statewide. (Under current law, pickup truck registrations are disregarded in the distribution formula.)

Effective: July 1, 2013.

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HOUSE BILL No. 1072



A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning transportation.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 8-14-2-4, AS AMENDED BY P.L.182-2007,
 2 SECTION 2, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
 3 JULY 1, 2013]: Sec. 4. (a) The auditor of state shall establish a special
 4 account to be called the "local road and street account" and **shall** credit
 5 this account monthly with forty-five percent (45%) of the money
 6 deposited in the highway, road and street fund.
 7 (b) The auditor **of state** shall distribute to units of local government
 8 money from this account each month. Before making any other
 9 distributions under this chapter, the auditor shall distribute E85
 10 incentive payments to all political subdivisions entitled to a payment
 11 under section 8 of this chapter.
 12 (c) After distributing E85 incentive payments required under section
 13 8 of this chapter, the auditor of state shall allocate to each county the
 14 remaining money in this account **based on the basis** of the ratio of each
 15 county's passenger car **and pickup truck** registrations to the total
 16 passenger car **and pickup truck** registrations of the state. **For**
 17 **purposes of this allocation, a pickup truck is a truck that is**



1 **registered under IC 9-18-2-8 as a truck with a declared gross**
 2 **weight of not more than eleven thousand (11,000) pounds.** The
 3 auditor **of state** shall further determine the suballocation between the
 4 county and the cities within the county as follows:

5 (1) In counties having a population of more than fifty thousand
 6 (50,000), sixty percent (60%) of the money shall be distributed on
 7 the basis of the population of the city or town as a percentage of
 8 the total population of the county and forty percent (40%)
 9 distributed on the basis of the ratio of city and town street mileage
 10 to county road mileage.

11 (2) In counties having a population of fifty thousand (50,000) or
 12 less, twenty percent (20%) of the money shall be distributed on
 13 the basis of the population of the city or town as a percentage of
 14 the total population of the county and eighty percent (80%)
 15 distributed on the basis of the ratio of city and town street mileage
 16 to county road mileage.

17 (3) ~~For the purposes of allocating funds as provided in this~~
 18 ~~section, towns which become incorporated as a town~~ **A town that**
 19 **incorporates** between the effective dates of decennial censuses
 20 ~~shall be becomes~~ eligible for allocations **under this section** upon
 21 the effectiveness of a corrected population count for the town
 22 under IC 1-1-3.5.

23 (4) Money allocated under the provisions of this section to
 24 counties containing a consolidated city shall be credited or
 25 allocated to the department of transportation of the consolidated
 26 city.

27 (d) Each month the auditor of state shall inform the department of
 28 the amounts allocated to each unit of local government from the local
 29 road and street account.

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
