DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Synopsis: Polling places. Provides that a public school building may be used as a polling place only if the governing body of the school corporation adopts a policy permitting the use of the school building as a polling place.

Effective: July 1, 2013.

HOUSE BILL No. 1156



A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning elections.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 3-11-8-4 IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS
2 [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2013]: Sec. 4. ~~School buildings~~, **(a) Except as**
3 **provided in subsection (b)**, fire stations and all other public buildings
4 shall be made available without charge to a county for holding an
5 election.
6 **(b) A school building of a public school corporation may be used**
7 **as a polling place only if the governing body of the school**
8 **corporation adopts a policy permitting the use of the school**
9 **building as a polling place.**
10 **(c) The county may not be required to sign any agreement assuming**
11 **liability as a precondition for use of ~~the~~ a public building for holding**
12 **an election.**
