## DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

**Citations Affected:** IC 9-21-16-9.

**Synopsis:** Suspension of court costs for parking violation. Provides that a court may suspend court costs for which a person is liable due to a violation of the requirement that a vehicle parked on a roadway with an adjacent curb must be parked with the vehicle's right-hand wheels parallel with and within 12 inches of the right-hand curb.

**Effective:** July 1, 2013.

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning motor vehicles.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:*

- 1 SECTION 1. IC 9-21-16-9 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
- 2 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2013]: Sec. 9. **(a)** A person who
- 3 violates this chapter commits a Class C infraction.
- 4 **(b) Notwithstanding IC 33-37-4-2, any court may suspend**
- 5 **applicable court costs (including fees) for which a person is liable**
- 6 **due to a traffic violation under section 7(a) of this chapter.**
