
HOUSE BILL No. 1260

DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 4-13.6-2-13; IC 5-22-14.1; IC 5-22-15-23.

Synopsis: Veterans business set aside. Authorizes a state agency to set aside certain contracts for supplies or services for service disabled veteran owned (SDVO) small businesses. Permits the department of administration to designate certain public works projects as an SDVO small business set-aside. Provides that to qualify for a set-aside contract, the SDVO small business must: (1) be owned and controlled by a service disabled veteran who is a resident of Indiana; and (2) have a current verification as an SDVO small business by the United States Department of Veterans Affairs Center of Veterans Enterprise. Provides, with certain exceptions, that a state agency must set a goal for participation by SDVO small businesses of at least 3% of the overall dollar amount expended each state fiscal year by the state agency for purchases. Provides that the Indiana economic development corporation may assist a state agency in: (1) compiling a list of SDVO small business; (2) assisting an SDVO small business in complying with the procedures for bidding on governmental contracts; (3) examining requests from state agencies for the purchase of supplies or services to help determine which purchases are to be designated as SDVO small business set-asides; and (4) simplifying specifications and contract terms to increase the opportunities for SDVO small business participation in governmental contracts. Requires the department of administration, beginning in 2014, to submit to the legislative council and the governor an annual report regarding state agency progress in meeting the 3% goal for SDVO small business contracts. Provides that an SDVO small business may not receive an Indiana small business price preference on purchases designated as an SDVO small business set-aside.

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Effective: Upon passage; July 1, 2013.

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HOUSE BILL No. 1260



A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning state and local administration.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 4-13.6-2-13 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
2 AS A **NEW** SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY
3 1, 2013]: **Sec. 13. (a) The division may designate a public works
4 project as an SDVO small business set-aside (as defined in
5 IC 5-22-14.1-2) under rules adopted by the department under
6 IC 4-22-2.**

7 **(b) The following apply to rules adopted by the department
8 governing small business set-asides for public works projects:**

9 **(1) The rules are subject to the criteria for determining
10 whether a business is an SDVO small business under
11 IC 5-22-14.1-5.**

12 **(2) The rules must establish procedures for administering an
13 SDVO small business set-aside program for public works
14 projects that are substantially the same as the procedures
15 described in IC 5-22-14.1.**

16 SECTION 2. IC 5-22-14.1 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
17 AS A **NEW** CHAPTER TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE



1 JULY 1, 2013]:

2 **Chapter 14.1. Indiana Service Disabled Veteran Owned Small**
3 **Business Set-Aside Purchases**

4 **Sec. 1. As used in this chapter, "SDVO small business" means**
5 **a service disabled veteran owned small business that meets the**
6 **requirements of section 5 of this chapter.**

7 **Sec. 2. As used in this chapter, "SDVO small business set-aside"**
8 **means a purchase in which the solicitation states that offers will be**
9 **accepted only from SDVO small businesses.**

10 **Sec. 3. As used in this chapter, "service disabled veteran" has**
11 **the meaning set forth in 15 U.S.C. 632(q)(1) as in effect January 1,**
12 **2013.**

13 **Sec. 4. As used in this chapter, "service disabled veteran owned**
14 **small business" means a small business concern owned and**
15 **controlled by service disabled veterans (as defined in 15 U.S.C.**
16 **632(q)(2) as in effect January 1, 2013).**

17 **Sec. 5. To qualify as an SDVO small business for purposes of**
18 **this chapter, a service disabled veteran owned small business must:**

19 (1) **be owned and controlled by a service disabled veteran who**
20 **is a resident of Indiana; and**

21 (2) **have a current verification as a service disabled veteran**
22 **owned small business under 38 CFR 74, et seq., by the United**
23 **States Department of Veterans Affairs Center of Veterans**
24 **Enterprise.**

25 **Sec. 6. (a) A state agency may identify as an SDVO small**
26 **business set-aside specific supplies or services for which a purchase**
27 **has been requested under this article.**

28 (b) **An SDVO small business must meet the requirements**
29 **provided in section 5 of this chapter at the time the solicitation for**
30 **the purchase is issued, and the public notice of the purchase must**
31 **state that the purchase is an SDVO small business set-aside.**

32 **Sec. 7. If a purchase is designated as an SDVO small business**
33 **set-aside, the solicitation must be confined to SDVO small**
34 **businesses.**

35 **Sec. 8. A purchasing agent may not designate a purchase as an**
36 **SDVO small business set-aside unless there is a reasonable**
37 **expectation that offers will be obtained from at least two (2) SDVO**
38 **small businesses capable of furnishing the desired supply or service**
39 **at a fair and reasonable price.**

40 **Sec. 9. (a) Except as provided in subsection (b), each state**
41 **agency shall set a goal for participation by SDVO small businesses**
42 **of at least three percent (3%) of the overall dollar amount**

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1 expended each state fiscal year by the state agency for purchases.

2 (b) A state agency is not required to meet the goal described in
3 subsection (a) if the state agency:

4 (1) determines that the goal is not consistent with the goals of
5 delivering the supplies or services within a timely manner and
6 within the budgeted amount; or

7 (2) exercising financial prudence, determines that the state
8 agency is unable to meet the goal established by subsection
9 (a).

10 Sec. 10. (a) Except as provided in subsection (b), a contract shall
11 be awarded under this chapter to the lowest responsible and
12 responsive offeror among the SDVO small businesses in
13 accordance with the rules of the Indiana department of
14 administration.

15 (b) If a purchasing agent determines that acceptance of the
16 lowest responsible and responsive offer will result in the payment
17 of an unreasonable price, the purchasing agent shall reject all
18 offers and may withdraw designation of the purchase as an SDVO
19 small business set-aside.

20 Sec. 11. A purchase from an SDVO small business under this
21 chapter is subject to:

22 (1) all other provisions of this article; and

23 (2) the rules of the Indiana department of administration.

24 If there is a conflict between the laws described in subdivisions (1)
25 and (2) and this chapter, this chapter governs.

26 Sec. 12. An SDVO small business may not receive a price
27 preference under IC 5-22-15-23 for purchases designated as an
28 SDVO small business set-aside under this chapter.

29 Sec. 13. The Indiana economic development corporation may
30 assist a state agency in doing any of the following:

31 (1) Compiling and maintaining a comprehensive list of SDVO
32 small businesses.

33 (2) Assisting SDVO small businesses in complying with the
34 procedures for bidding on government contracts.

35 (3) Examining requests from state agencies for the purchase
36 of supplies or services to help determine which purchases are
37 to be designated as SDVO small business set-asides.

38 (4) Simplifying specifications and contract terms to increase
39 the opportunities for SDVO small business participation in
40 government contracts.

41 Sec. 14. (a) The Indiana department of administration shall
42 annually evaluate the progress of each state agency in meeting the

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1 goal established by section 9 of this chapter for the previous state
2 fiscal year.

3 (b) Beginning in 2014, after June 30 and before November 1 of
4 each year, the Indiana department of administration shall submit
5 a report to the governor and the legislative council (in an electronic
6 format under IC 5-14-6). The report must include:

7 (1) a list of each state agency that failed to meet the goal
8 established by section 9 of this chapter during the previous
9 state fiscal year; and

10 (2) for each state agency described in subdivision (1):

11 (A) a summary of why the state agency failed to meet the
12 goal; and

13 (B) the actions that are being taken by the state agency to
14 meet the goal in the current state fiscal year.

15 (c) The Indiana department of administration shall post the
16 report described in subsection (b) on the department's Internet
17 web site not later than thirty (30) days after the report is submitted
18 to the governor and the legislative council.

19 **Sec. 15. The Indiana department of administration shall adopt**
20 **rules under IC 4-22-2 to implement this chapter.**

21 SECTION 3. IC 5-22-15-23 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
22 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2013]: Sec. 23. (a) **Except as**
23 **provided in IC 5-22-14.1-12**, a governmental body shall give a fifteen
24 percent (15%) preference for supplies to an Indiana small business (as
25 defined in IC 5-22-14-1) that submits an offer for purchase under this
26 article.

27 (b) The governmental body may adopt rules to establish criteria to
28 carry out this section.

29 SECTION 4. [EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE] (a) **The Indiana**
30 **department of administration may adopt emergency rules in the**
31 **manner provided under IC 4-22-2-37.1 to implement**
32 **IC 4-13.6-2-13 and IC 5-22-14.1, both as added by this act, and**
33 **IC 5-22-15-23, as amended by this act.**

34 (b) An emergency rule adopted under this SECTION expires on
35 the earlier of:

36 (1) the date the Indiana department of administration adopts
37 permanent rules under IC 4-22-2 to replace the emergency
38 rules; or

39 (2) December 31, 2014.

40 (c) This SECTION expires January 1, 2015.

41 SECTION 5. An emergency is declared for this act.

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
