A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning higher education.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 21-45-2-2, AS ADDED BY P.L.2-2007, SECTION
2 286, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY
3 1, 2013]: Sec. 2. (a) The Indiana University ~~department~~ **school** of
4 public health shall provide instruction of students in public health
5 problems, personnel, and equipment. The Indiana University
6 ~~department~~ **school** of public health may provide short courses in:
7 (1) public health practice for physicians;
8 (2) dental health practice for dentists; and
9 (3) public health for nurses and all other persons desiring to
10 develop a technical understanding in public health matters.
11 The courses provided under this section may also be provided for lay
12 groups in phases of public health and sanitary measures appropriate to
13 the occupation or profession of the groups.
14 (b) The courses provided under this section may be held at any
15 convenient place in Indiana.
16 (c) The courses provided under this section for nurses must be
17 planned in cooperation with the director of nursing education for
