DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 3-9-4-5.

Synopsis: Campaign finance reports. Provides that the election division and county election boards must make a campaign finance report or statement available for public inspection and copying not later than the end of the seventh business day following the day on which the report or statement is received. (Under current law, the report or statement must be available to the public not later than the end of the second business day following the day on which the report or statement is received.)

Effective: July 1, 2013.

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning elections.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 3-9-4-5 IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS
2 [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2013]: Sec. 5. (a) The election division and
3 each county election board shall make the reports and statements filed
4 with them available for public inspection and copying, commencing as
5 soon as practicable but not later than the end of the ~~second~~ **seventh**
6 business day following the day during which they were received.
7 (b) The election division and the county election boards shall also
8 permit copying of a report or statement by hand or by duplicating
9 machine, as requested, at the expense of the person and subject to
10 IC 5-14-3-8. Inspection and copying of records contained on the
11 computer system described in section 4(b) of this chapter are subject
12 to IC 5-14-3.
13 (c) A person may not sell information copied from reports and
14 statements under this section or use it for a commercial purpose.
15 However, this restriction does not apply to a newspaper, magazine,
16 book, or other communication with a principal purpose other than
17 communicating contributor information:



- 1 (1) to solicit contributions; or
- 2 (2) for other commercial purposes.
