

HOUSE BILL No. 1587

DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 9-13-2-30.5; IC 9-14-3-5; IC 9-24; IC 9-29; IC 34-30-2-31.5; IC 35-43-5-2; IC 35-48-7-5; IC 35-51-9-1.

Synopsis: Commercial identification cards from the BMV. Requires the bureau of motor vehicles (BMV) to issue commercial identification cards that do not bear the photograph of the holder, to be used for the limited purpose of commercial transactions. Specifies that a commercial identification card may not be accepted by a federal agency or for a federal purpose, or to operate a motor vehicle. Sets a fee of \$6 for the issuance, renewal, amendment, or replacement of a commercial identification card. Makes technical corrections.

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning motor vehicles.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 9-13-2-30.5 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
2 ASA **NEW** SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY
3 1, 2013]: **Sec. 30.5. "Commercial identification card" means an**
4 **identification card issued by the bureau for the limited purpose of**
5 **commercial transactions.**

6 SECTION 2. IC 9-14-3-5, AS AMENDED BY P.L.125-2012,
7 SECTION 34, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
8 JULY 1, 2013]: Sec. 5. (a) Except as provided in subsection (b), (d), or
9 (e), the bureau shall prepare and deliver information on titles,
10 registrations, and licenses and permits upon the request of any person.
11 All requests must be:
12 (1) submitted in writing; or
13 (2) made electronically through the computer gateway
14 administered under IC 4-13.1-2-2(a)(5) by the office of
15 technology;
16 to the bureau and, unless exempted under IC 9-29, must be
17 accompanied by the payment of the fee prescribed in IC 9-29-2-2.



1 (b) The bureau shall not disclose:
 2 (1) the Social Security number;
 3 (2) the federal identification number;
 4 (3) the driver's license number;
 5 (4) the digital image of the driver's license applicant;
 6 (5) a reproduction of the signature secured under IC 9-24-9-1, ~~or~~
 7 IC 9-24-16-3, **or IC 9-24-16.5-2**; or
 8 (6) medical or disability information;
 9 of any person except as provided in subsection (c).

10 (c) The bureau may disclose any information listed in subsection
 11 (b):

- 12 (1) to a law enforcement officer;
 13 (2) to an agent or a designee of the department of state revenue;
 14 (3) for uses permitted under IC 9-14-3.5-10(1), IC 9-14-3.5-10(4),
 15 IC 9-14-3.5-10(6), and IC 9-14-3.5-10(9); or
 16 (4) for voter registration and election purposes required under
 17 IC 3-7 or IC 9-24-2.5.

18 (d) As provided under 42 U.S.C. 1973gg-3(b), the bureau may not
 19 disclose any information concerning the failure of an applicant for a
 20 motor vehicle driver's license to sign a voter registration application,
 21 except as authorized under IC 3-7-14.

22 (e) The bureau may not disclose any information concerning the
 23 failure of an applicant for a title, registration, license, or permit (other
 24 than a motor vehicle license described under subsection (d)) to sign a
 25 voter registration application, except as authorized under IC 3-7-14.

26 SECTION 3. IC 9-24-11-4, AS AMENDED BY P.L.184-2007,
 27 SECTION 37, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
 28 JULY 1, 2013]: Sec. 4. (a) An individual may not have more than one
 29 (1) valid driver's license at a time.

30 (b) An individual may not hold a driver's license and an
 31 identification card issued under IC 9-24-16 at the same time.

32 **(c) An individual may not hold a driver's license and a**
 33 **commercial identification card issued under IC 9-24-16.5 at the**
 34 **same time.**

35 SECTION 4. IC 9-24-12-4, AS AMENDED BY P.L.109-2011,
 36 SECTION 10, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
 37 JULY 1, 2013]: Sec. 4. (a) Except as provided in subsections (b) and
 38 (c), the application for renewal of:

- 39 (1) an operator's license;
 40 (2) a chauffeur's license;
 41 (3) a public passenger chauffeur's license; ~~or~~
 42 (4) an identification card; **or**

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1 **(5) a commercial identification card;**
 2 under this article may be filed not more than twelve (12) months before
 3 the expiration date of the license, ~~or~~ identification card, **or commercial**
 4 **identification card** held by the applicant.

5 (b) When the applicant complies with IC 9-24-9-2.5(5) through
 6 IC 9-24-9-2.5(10), an application for renewal of a driver's license in
 7 subsection (a)(1), (a)(2), or (a)(3) may be filed not more than one (1)
 8 month before the expiration date of the license held by the applicant.

9 (c) When the applicant complies with IC 9-24-16-3.5(1)(E) through
 10 IC 9-24-16-3.5(1)(J), an application for renewal of an identification
 11 card in subsection ~~(a)(5)~~ **(a)(4)** may be filed not more than one (1)
 12 month before the expiration date of the identification card held by the
 13 applicant.

14 SECTION 5. IC 9-24-16-0.5 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
 15 AS A **NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS** [EFFECTIVE JULY
 16 1, 2013]: **Sec. 0.5. This chapter does not apply to commercial**
 17 **identification cards.**

18 SECTION 6. IC 9-24-16-14 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
 19 AS A **NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS** [EFFECTIVE JULY
 20 1, 2013]: **Sec. 14. (a) An individual may not hold an identification**
 21 **card and a commercial identification card issued under**
 22 **IC 9-24-16.5 at the same time.**

23 **(b) An individual who violates this section commits a Class C**
 24 **infraction.**

25 SECTION 7. IC 9-24-16.5 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
 26 AS A **NEW CHAPTER TO READ AS FOLLOWS** [EFFECTIVE
 27 JULY 1, 2013]:

28 **Chapter 16.5. Commercial Identification Cards**

29 **Sec. 1. The bureau shall issue a commercial identification card**
 30 **to an individual who meets the following conditions:**

- 31 **(1) Makes an application.**
 32 **(2) Is a resident of Indiana.**

33 **Sec. 2. (a) An application for a commercial identification card**
 34 **issued under this chapter must require the following information**
 35 **concerning an applicant:**

- 36 **(1) The full legal name of the applicant.**
 37 **(2) The applicant's date of birth.**
 38 **(3) The gender of the applicant.**
 39 **(4) The applicant's height, weight, hair color, and eye color.**
 40 **(5) The principal address and mailing address of the**
 41 **applicant.**
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- 1 (A) valid Social Security number;
 2 (B) verification of an applicant's ineligibility to be issued a
 3 Social Security number; or
 4 (C) statement from the applicant wherein the applicant
 5 swears or affirms that the applicant has a sincerely held
 6 religious belief against the issuance of a Social Security
 7 number to the applicant and a copy of Form 4029 from the
 8 United States Internal Revenue Service concerning the
 9 applicant.
- 10 (7) The signature of the applicant.
- 11 (8) A statement:
- 12 (A) from the applicant in which the applicant swears or
 13 affirms that the applicant has a sincerely held religious
 14 belief against the taking of a photograph of the applicant;
 15 and
 16 (B) from a member of the clergy of the religious
 17 organization of which the applicant is a member regarding
 18 the prohibition of photography of members of the religious
 19 organization.
- 20 The bureau shall maintain records of the information provided
 21 under subdivisions (1) through (8).
- 22 (b) The bureau may invalidate a commercial identification card
 23 that the bureau believes to have been issued as a result of
 24 fraudulent documentation.
- 25 (c) The bureau:
- 26 (1) shall adopt rules under IC 4-22-2 to establish a procedure
 27 to verify an applicant's identity; and
 28 (2) may adopt rules to establish a procedure to temporarily
 29 invalidate a commercial identification card that the bureau
 30 believes to have been issued based on fraudulent
 31 documentation.
- 32 Sec. 3. (a) A commercial identification card must have the same
 33 dimensions and shape as a driver's license and an identification
 34 card issued under IC 9-24-16, but the commercial identification
 35 card must have markings sufficient to distinguish the card from a
 36 driver's license or an identification card.
- 37 (b) The front side of a commercial identification card must
 38 contain the expiration date of the commercial identification card
 39 and the following information about the individual to whom the
 40 card is being issued:
- 41 (1) Full legal name.
 42 (2) The address of the principal residence.

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- 1 **(3) Date of birth.**
 2 **(4) Date of issue and date of expiration.**
 3 **(5) Unique identification number.**
 4 **(6) Gender.**
 5 **(7) Weight.**
 6 **(8) Height.**
 7 **(9) Color of eyes and hair.**
 8 **(10) Reproduction of the signature of the individual identified.**
 9 **(11) If the individual is less than eighteen (18) years of age at**
 10 **the time of issuance, the dates on which the individual will**
 11 **become:**
 12 **(A) eighteen (18) years of age; and**
 13 **(B) twenty-one (21) years of age.**
 14 **(12) If the individual is at least eighteen (18) years of age but**
 15 **less than twenty-one (21) years of age at the time of issuance,**
 16 **the date on which the individual will become twenty-one (21)**
 17 **years of age.**
 18 **(c) The information contained on the commercial identification**
 19 **card as required by subsection (b)(11) or (b)(12) for an individual**
 20 **who is less than twenty-one (21) years of age at the time of issuance**
 21 **must be printed prominently on the commercial identification**
 22 **card.**
 23 **Sec. 4. A commercial identification card must include a**
 24 **statement on the card that indicates that the commercial**
 25 **identification card may not be accepted by any federal agency for**
 26 **federal identification or any other federal purpose.**
 27 **Sec. 5. (a) A commercial identification card expires at midnight**
 28 **of the birthday of the holder that occurs six (6) years following the**
 29 **date of issuance.**
 30 **(b) An application for renewal of a commercial identification**
 31 **card may be made not more than twelve (12) months before the**
 32 **expiration date of the card.**
 33 **(c) A renewed commercial identification card is valid on the**
 34 **birth date of the holder and remains valid for six (6) years.**
 35 **(d) Renewal may not be granted if the cardholder was issued a**
 36 **driver's license or an identification card after the last issuance of**
 37 **a commercial identification card.**
 38 **Sec. 6. (a) The bureau shall issue:**
 39 **(1) an amended commercial identification card if any**
 40 **information contained on the commercial identification card**
 41 **becomes invalid or obsolete; or**
 42 **(2) a replacement commercial identification card if the card**

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1 is lost, stolen, damaged, or destroyed.

2 (b) If information on a commercial identification card becomes
3 invalid or obsolete, the holder shall, within thirty (30) days after
4 the card becomes invalid or obsolete, apply for an amended card
5 containing correct information.

6 (c) If a commercial identification card is destroyed or damaged,
7 the holder may apply for a replacement card.

8 Sec. 7. The bureau may adopt rules under IC 4-22-2 and
9 prescribe all forms necessary to implement this chapter.

10 Sec. 8. A commercial identification card issued under this
11 chapter may not be used to identify the individual who holds the
12 commercial identification card as the operator of a motor vehicle.

13 Sec. 9. (a) An individual may not hold a commercial
14 identification card and an identification card issued under
15 IC 9-24-16 at the same time.

16 (b) An individual who violates this section commits a Class C
17 infraction.

18 Sec. 10. (a) A person who:

19 (1) knowingly permits the use of a commercial identification
20 card issued under this chapter by a person other than the
21 person to whom the card was issued;

22 (2) knowingly displays or represents as the person's own
23 commercial identification card issued under this chapter a
24 commercial identification card that was not issued to the
25 person displaying the card;

26 (3) knowingly or intentionally does not surrender, upon
27 demand of the proper official, a commercial identification
28 card issued under this chapter that has become invalid or
29 expired; or

30 (4) knowingly sells, offers to sell, buys, possesses, or offers a
31 false identification card that could reasonably be mistaken for
32 a valid commercial identification card required by this
33 chapter to be issued by the bureau but that has not been
34 issued by the bureau;

35 commits a Class B misdemeanor.

36 (b) A person who:

37 (1) knowingly or intentionally uses false information in an
38 application:

39 (A) for a commercial identification card issued under this
40 chapter; or

41 (B) for a renewal, amendment, or replacement of a
42 commercial identification card issued under this chapter;

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1 or

2 (2) knowingly or intentionally makes a false statement or
 3 otherwise commits fraud in an application for a commercial
 4 identification card issued under this chapter;
 5 commits application fraud, a Class D felony.

6 Sec. 11. A person who forges or reproduces a commercial
 7 identification card issued under this chapter:

- 8 (1) with intent to use the commercial identification card; or
 9 (2) with intent that the commercial identification card may be
 10 used by another person;

11 commits a Class B misdemeanor.

12 Sec. 12. The commissioner and the employees or agents of the
 13 bureau are not civilly responsible for the validity of information
 14 contained on a commercial identification card issued under this
 15 chapter. The bureau may adopt rules under IC 4-22-2 to place an
 16 appropriate disclaimer on a commercial identification card.

17 SECTION 8. IC 9-29-3-14, AS AMENDED BY P.L.1-2007,
 18 SECTION 88, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
 19 JULY 1, 2013]: Sec. 14. (a) Fifty cents (\$0.50) of each service charge
 20 collected under this section shall be deposited in the state motor
 21 vehicle technology fund established by IC 9-29-16-1.

22 (b) The service charge for an identification card issued under
 23 ~~IC 9-24~~ **IC 9-24-16** is seventy-five cents (\$0.75) and one-half (1/2) of
 24 each fee collected as set forth in ~~IC 9-29-9-15~~. **IC 9-29-9-15(a)**.

25 (c) **The service charge for a commercial identification card**
 26 **issued under IC 9-24-16.5 is seventy-five cents (\$0.75) and one-half**
 27 **(1/2) of each fee collected as set forth in IC 9-29-9-15(b).**

28 SECTION 9. IC 9-29-9-15, AS AMENDED BY P.L.109-2011,
 29 SECTION 35, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
 30 JULY 1, 2013]: Sec. 15. (a) The fees for the issuance, renewal,
 31 amendment, or replacement of an identification card under IC 9-24-16
 32 are as follows:

33 (1) For an individual at least sixty-five (65) years of age or an
 34 individual with a physical disability and not entitled to obtain a
 35 driver's license, three dollars and fifty cents (\$3.50).

36 (2) For any other individual, six dollars (\$6).

37 (b) **The fee for the issuance, renewal, amendment, or**
 38 **replacement of a commercial identification card under**
 39 **IC 9-24-16.5 is six dollars (\$6).**

19 (D) by authority of one who did not give authority;

20 commits counterfeiting, a Class D felony.

21 (b) A person who, with intent to defraud, makes, utters, or possesses
 22 a written instrument in such a manner that it purports to have been
 23 made:

24 (1) by another person;

25 (2) at another time;

26 (3) with different provisions; or

27 (4) by authority of one who did not give authority;

28 commits forgery, a Class C felony.

29 (c) This subsection applies to a person who applies for a driver's
 30 license (as defined in IC 9-13-2-48). A person who:

31 (1) knowingly or intentionally uses a false or fictitious name or
 32 gives a false or fictitious address in an application for a driver's
 33 license or for a renewal or a duplicate of a driver's license; or

34 (2) knowingly or intentionally makes a false statement or conceals
 35 a material fact or otherwise commits fraud in an application for a
 36 driver's license;

37 commits application fraud, a Class D felony.

38 (d) This subsection applies to a person who applies for a state
 39 identification card (as issued under IC 9-24-16). A person who:

40 (1) knowingly or intentionally uses false information in a
 41 application for an identification card or for a renewal or duplicate
 42 of an identification card; or

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1 (2) knowingly or intentionally makes a false statement or
 2 otherwise commits fraud in an application for an identification
 3 card;
 4 commits application fraud, a Class D felony.

5 **(e) This subsection applies to a person who applies for a**
