

SENATE MOTION

MADAM PRESIDENT:

I move that Senate Bill 246 be amended to read as follows:

- 1 Page 2, between lines 5 and 6, begin a new line block indented and
2 insert:
3 **"(4) A pharmacy holding a permit issued under IC 25-26-13.**
4 **(5) An optometrist licensed under IC 25-24.**
5 **(6) A health facility licensed under IC 16-28."**
6 Page 2, line 13, delete "a health facility licensed under IC 16-28."
7 and insert "**a hospice licensed under IC 16-25.**"
8 Page 2, delete lines 14 through 42, begin a new line blocked left and
9 insert:
10 **"A physician licensed under IC 25-22.5 must hold a majority**
11 **interest in the entity and the remaining interest must be held by a**
12 **health care provider licensed in Indiana.**
13 SECTION 2. IC 25-22.5-13 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
14 AS A NEW CHAPTER TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
15 JULY 1, 2013]:
16 **Chapter 13. Controlled Substance Rules**
17 **Sec. 1. (a) Before October 31, 2013, the board shall adopt**
18 **emergency rules in the manner provided under IC 4-22-2-37.1**
19 **related to the prescribing of controlled substances to establish a**
20 **process for the office of the attorney general to follow to access a**
21 **physician's records and inventory.**
22 **(b) The rules adopted under this section may not affect any**
23 **other process the attorney general is authorized to follow in**
24 **obtaining records for an investigation."**
25 Page 3, delete lines 1 through 23.
26 Page 3, line 24, delete "1." and insert "2."
27 Page 3, line 26, delete "and" and insert "**standards and protocols**
28 **for the prescribing of controlled substances."**
29 Page 3, delete lines 27 through 42.
30 Page 4, delete lines 1 through 6.

- 1 Page 4, line 7, delete "2." and insert "3."
- 2 Page 4, line 11, delete "as part of the controlled drug prescribing
- 3 oversight".
- 4 Page 4, line 12, delete "program".
- 5 Page 4, line 12, delete "section 1 of".
- 6 Page 4, line 13, delete "3." and insert "4."
- 7 Page 4, line 16, delete "4." and insert "5."
- 8 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
