

SENATE MOTION

MADAM PRESIDENT:

I move that Engrossed House Bill 1334 be amended to read as follows:

- 1 Page 24, between lines 2 and 3, begin a new paragraph and insert:
2 "SECTION 6. IC 20-32-8.5-2, AS AMENDED BY P.L.160-2012,
3 SECTION 53, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
4 UPON PASSAGE]: Sec. 2. (a) Except as provided in subsection (b) or
5 (c), the plan required by this chapter must include the following:
6 (1) Reading skill standards for grade 1 through grade 3.
7 (2) An emphasis on a method for making determinant evaluations
8 by grade 3 that might require remedial action for the student, **with**
9 **an emphasis on a growth measure at each grade level. The**
10 **evaluations must be based on two (2) or more assessments**
11 **made throughout the school year. The plan must require that**
12 **the student's achievement and growth be taken into account**
13 **when determining the appropriate remedial action, which**
14 **may include including retention as a last resort, after other**
15 **methods of remediation have been evaluated or used, or both, if**
16 reading skills are below the standard. Appropriate consultation
17 with parents or guardians must be part of the plan.
18 **(3) An emphasis on a home and school reading initiative with**
19 **appropriate consultation with parents to accelerate the**
20 **reading improvement of a student.**
21 ~~(3)~~ **(4)** The fiscal impact of each component of the plan, if any. In
22 determining whether a component has a fiscal impact,
23 consideration shall be given to whether the component will
24 increase costs to the state or a school corporation or require the
25 state or school corporation to reallocate resources.
26 (b) For a charter school, as defined in IC 20-24-1-4, a plan may
27 include only the following:
28 (1) A method for making determinant evaluations of reading skills
29 by grade 3.
30 (2) Retention as a last resort for students reading below grade

- 1 level as measured by the evaluation or assessment.
- 2 (c) This subsection applies to a public school that is not a charter
- 3 school. A school corporation may receive a waiver of the requirements
- 4 provided in 511 IAC 6.2-3.1-4(a)(2) if the state board approves an
- 5 alternative reading plan provided by the school corporation."
- 6 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
