

# COMMITTEE REPORT

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## MADAM PRESIDENT:

The Senate Committee on Rules and Legislative Procedure, to which was referred Senate Bill No. 412, has had the same under consideration and begs leave to report the same back to the Senate with the recommendation that said bill be AMENDED as follows:

- 1 Delete everything after the enacting clause and insert the  
2 following:  
3 SECTION 1. IC 16-28-15-8, AS ADDED BY P.L.229-2011,  
4 SECTION 162, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS  
5 [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2013]: Sec. 8. (a) The money collected from the  
6 quality assessment fee during ~~the first year following the enactment~~  
7 **state fiscal year 2012** may be used only as follows:  
8 (1) Sixty-seven and one-tenth percent (67.1%) to pay the state's  
9 share of costs for Medicaid nursing facility services provided  
10 under Title XIX of the federal Social Security Act (42 U.S.C.  
11 1396 et seq.).  
12 (2) Twenty-three and eight-tenths percent (23.8%) to pay the  
13 state's share of costs for other Medicaid services provided under  
14 Title XIX of the federal Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1396 et  
15 seq.).  
16 (3) Nine and one-tenth percent (9.1%) to pay prior year state  
17 nursing facility expenditures.  
18 (b) The money collected from the quality assessment fee during  
19 ~~the second year following enactment~~ **state fiscal year 2013** may be  
20 used only as follows:  
21 (1) Sixty-six and five-tenths percent (66.5%) to pay the state's  
22 share of costs for Medicaid nursing facility services provided  
23 under Title XIX of the federal Social Security Act (42 U.S.C.  
24 1396 et seq.).  
25 (2) Twenty-nine and four-tenths percent (29.4%) to pay the  
26 state's share of costs for other Medicaid services provided under

1 Title XIX of the federal Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1396 et  
2 seq.).

3 (3) Four and one-tenth percent (4.1%) to pay prior year state  
4 nursing facility expenditures.

5 (c) The money collected from the quality assessment fee after ~~the~~  
6 ~~second year following enactment state fiscal year 2013~~ may be used  
7 only as follows:

8 (1) Seventy and six-tenths percent (70.6%) to pay the state's  
9 share of the costs for Medicaid nursing facility services provided  
10 under Title XIX of the federal Social Security Act (42 U.S.C.  
11 1396 et seq.).

12 (2) Twenty-nine and four-tenths percent (29.4%) to pay the  
13 state's share of costs for other Medicaid services provided under  
14 Title XIX of the federal Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1396 et  
15 seq.).

16 (d) Any increase in reimbursement for Medicaid nursing facility  
17 services resulting from maximizing the quality assessment rate under  
18 section 6(b) of this chapter shall be directed exclusively to initiatives  
19 determined by the office to promote and enhance improvements in  
20 quality of care to nursing facility residents.

21 (e) The office may establish a method to allow a health facility to  
22 enter into an agreement to pay the quality assessment fee collected  
23 under this chapter under an installment plan.

24 SECTION 2. IC 16-28-15-14, AS ADDED BY P.L.229-2011,  
25 SECTION 162, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS  
26 [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2013]: Sec. 14. This chapter expires June 30,  
27 ~~2014.~~ **2017.**
