SENATE BILL No. 409

DIGEST OF SB 409 (Updated February 25, 2013 3:44 pm - DI 71)

Citations Affected: IC 20-28.

Synopsis: Teacher preparation programs. Requires the department of education (department) to develop, and the state board of education (state board) to adopt as rules, standards and benchmarks of performance for teacher education schools, departments, and programs (teacher preparation programs), and graduates of those teacher preparation programs. Sets forth certain benchmarks and reporting requirements for teacher preparation programs. Requires the department and state board to develop a rating system for teacher preparation programs.

Effective: July 1, 2013.

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning education.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

COMMITTEE REPORT

Madam President: The Senate Committee on Education and Career Development, to which was referred Senate Bill No. 409, has had the same under consideration and begs leave to report the same back to the Senate with the recommendation that said bill be AMENDED as follows:

Page 1, between the enacting clause and line 1, begin a new paragraph and insert:

"SECTION 1. IC 20-28-3-1, AS ADDED BY P.L.246-2005, SECTION 147, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2013]: Sec. 1. (a) The department shall:

- (1) arrange a statewide system of professional instruction for teacher education;
- (2) accredit and inspect teacher education schools and departments that comply with the rules of the department;
- (3) recommend and approve courses for the education of particular kinds of teachers in accredited schools and departments; and
- (4) specify the types of licenses for graduates of approved courses.

(b) The department shall work with teacher education schools and departments to develop a system of teacher education that ensures individuals who graduate from the schools and departments are able to meet the highest professional standards.

(c) The department shall establish standards for the continuous improvement of program processes and the performance of graduates of teacher education schools and departments. The state board shall adopt rules containing the standards not later than two hundred seventy (270) days after the department finishes the standards.

(d) The standards established under subsection (c) must include benchmarks for performance, including at least the following:

- (1) A minimum percentage of graduates who obtain full-time teaching positions, and a minimum percentage of graduates who obtain part-time teaching positions.**
- (2) At least seventy percent (70%) of graduates must receive a rating of effective or highly effective on their evaluations under IC 20-28-11.5-4 for their first, second, and third years of teaching.**
- (3) A minimum average raw score of graduates on licensing tests.**
- (4) A maximum average number of times each graduate takes**

each licensing test before receiving a passing score.

(e) Each teacher education school and department shall annually report the school's or department's performance on the standards and benchmarks established under this section to the department. In addition to reporting performance, each teacher education school and department must report the following information:

- (1) The average grade point average of program candidates.
- (2) The attrition, retention, and completion rates of candidates.
- (3) The average raw scores of graduates on licensing tests, including academic proficiency, subject matter, and professional knowledge tests.
- (4) The average number of times each graduate takes each licensing test before receiving a passing score.
- (5) The percentage of graduates who obtain:
 - (A) full-time; and
 - (B) part-time;
 teaching positions.
- (6) The employer's name for each graduate who obtains a full-time or part-time teaching position.
- (7) The results of the evaluations required under IC 20-28-11.5-4 for graduates who are in their first, second, and third years of teaching.
- (8) Five-year retention rates for graduates in the teaching profession."
