SENATE BILL No. 434

DIGEST OF SB 434 (Updated February 4, 2013 2:48 pm - DI 109)

Citations Affected: IC 14-15.

Synopsis: Requirement for flotation devices for children. Prohibits a person from operating a boat unless each child less than 13 years of age onboard the boat is wearing a personal flotation device. Provides for certain exceptions. Requires that funds collected as a judgment for violating this prohibition be deposited in the conservation officers marine enforcement fund.

Effective: July 1, 2013.

SENATE BILL No. 434

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning natural and cultural resources.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

- 1 SECTION 1. IC 14-15-2-6.5 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
2 AS A **NEW** SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY
3 1, 2013]: **Sec. 6.5. (a) This section does not apply to boats while
4 used for commercial purposes.**
5 **(b) Except as provided in subsection (c), a person may not
6 operate a boat unless each child less than thirteen (13) years of age
7 onboard the boat is wearing a personal flotation device approved
8 by the United States Coast Guard.**
9 **(c) Subsection (b) does not apply during a period in which:**
10 **(1) the child is below deck;**
11 **(2) the child is in an enclosed cabin;**
12 **(3) the boat is docked or aground;**
13 **(4) the boat is moored or anchored; or**
14 **(5) the boat is within a regulated idle zone area.**
15 **(d) Notwithstanding IC 34-28-5-5(c), the funds collected as a
