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## SENATE BILL No. 554

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DIGEST OF SB 554 (Updated February 6, 2013 3:48 pm - DI 104)

**Citations Affected:** IC 12-7; IC 12-15.

**Synopsis:** Telehealth and telemedicine services under Medicaid. Requires the office of Medicaid policy and planning to reimburse: (1) a home health agency for telehealth services; and (2) a federally qualified health center and a rural health clinic for telemedicine services; under the Medicaid program.

**Effective:** July 1, 2013.

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## SENATE BILL No. 554

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning Medicaid.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:*

1 SECTION 1. IC 12-7-2-190.3 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA  
2 CODE AS A **NEW** SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS  
3 [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2013]: **Sec. 190.3. "Telehealth services", for**  
4 **purposes of IC 12-15-5-11, has the meaning set forth in**  
5 **IC 12-15-5-11(a).**

6 SECTION 2. IC 12-7-2-190.4 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA  
7 CODE AS A **NEW** SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS  
8 [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2013]: **Sec. 190.4. "Telemedicine services",**  
9 **for purposes of IC 12-15-5-11, has the meaning set forth in**  
10 **IC 12-15-5-11(b).**

11 SECTION 3. IC 12-15-5-11 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE  
12 AS A **NEW** SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY  
13 1, 2013]: **Sec. 11. (a) As used in this section, "telehealth services"**  
14 **means the use of telecommunications and information technology**  
15 **to provide access to health assessment, diagnosis, intervention,**  
16 **consultation, supervision, and information across a distance.**

17 (b) As used in this section, "telemedicine services" means a

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1 specific method of delivery of services, including medical exams  
2 and consultations, using videoconferencing equipment to allow a  
3 provider to render an examination or other service to a patient at  
4 a distant location. The term does not include the use of the  
5 following:  
6 (1) A telephone transmitter for transtelephonic monitoring.  
7 (2) A telephone or any other means of communication for the  
8 consultation from one (1) provider to another provider.  
9 (c) The office shall reimburse a Medicaid provider who is  
10 licensed as a home health agency under IC 16-27-1 for telehealth  
11 services.  
12 (d) The office shall reimburse the following Medicaid providers  
13 for telemedicine services:  
14 (1) A federally qualified health center (as defined in 42 U.S.C.  
15 1396d(l)(2)(B)).  
16 (2) A rural health clinic (as defined in 42 U.S.C. 1396d(l)(1)).  
17 (c) The office may adopt rules under IC 4-22-2 necessary to  
18 implement and administer this section.

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## COMMITTEE REPORT

Madam President: The Senate Committee on Health and Provider Services, to which was referred Senate Bill No. 554, has had the same under consideration and begs leave to report the same back to the Senate with the recommendation that said bill be AMENDED as follows:

Page 1, between lines 5 and 6, begin a new paragraph and insert:

"SECTION 2. IC 12-7-2-190.4 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2013]: **Sec. 190.4. "Telemedicine services", for purposes of IC 12-15-5-11, has the meaning set forth in IC 12-15-5-11(b).**".

Page 1, line 12, after "(b)" insert "As used in this section, "telemedicine services" means a specific method of delivery of services, including medical exams and consultations, using videoconferencing equipment to allow a provider to render an examination or other service to a patient at a distant location. The term does not include the use of the following:

- (1) A telephone transmitter for transtelephonic monitoring.
- (2) A telephone or any other means of communication for the consultation from one (1) provider to another provider.

(c)".

Page 1, line 12, delete "the following Medicaid providers" and insert "a Medicaid provider who is licensed as a home health agency under IC 16-27-1 for telehealth services."

Page 1, delete lines 13 through 15, begin a new paragraph and insert:

"(d) The office shall reimburse the following Medicaid providers for telemedicine services:".

Page 1, line 16, delete "(2)" and insert "(1)".

Page 2, line 1, delete "(3)" and insert "(2)".

Re-number all SECTIONS consecutively.

and when so amended that said bill do pass and be reassigned to the Senate Committee on Appropriations.
