DIGEST OF SB 561 (Updated January 28, 2013 11:34 am - DI 44)

Citations Affected: IC 4-23.

Synopsis: Indiana 2016 Bicentennial Commission. Creates the Indiana 2016 bicentennial commission to: (1) plan and develop activities appropriate to commemorate Indiana's statehood; (2) encourage private organizations and local governments to organize and participate in activities that highlight the bicentennial; and (3) help coordinate and promote bicentennial activities throughout Indiana.

Effective: December 1, 2011 (retroactive).

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SENATE BILL No. 561

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning state offices and administration.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

- 1 SECTION 1. IC 4-23-33 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE AS
2 A **NEW** CHAPTER TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
3 DECEMBER 1, 2011 (RETROACTIVE)]:
4 **Chapter 33. Indiana 2016 Bicentennial Commission**
5 **Sec. 1. As used in this chapter, "bicentennial" refers to the**
6 **bicentennial of Indiana's statehood.**
7 **Sec. 2. As used in this chapter, "commission" refers to the**
8 **Indiana 2016 bicentennial commission established by section 3 of**
9 **this chapter.**
10 **Sec. 3. The Indiana 2016 bicentennial commission is established.**
11 **Sec. 4. (a) The commission consists of members appointed by the**
12 **governor. Each member serves at the pleasure of the governor.**
13 **(b) The governor shall appoint the chairperson of the**
14 **commission.**
15 **(c) Each member of the commission serves a term that expires**
16 **June 30, 2017. If a vacancy occurs, the governor shall appoint a**
17 **successor to complete the unexpired term.**

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- 1 (d) The commission shall meet upon the call of the chairperson.
- 2 (e) A majority of the members appointed to the commission
- 3 constitutes a quorum for a meeting of the commission.
- 4 (f) Each member of the commission who is a member of the
- 5 general assembly is a nonvoting member.
- 6 (g) The affirmative votes of a majority of the voting members
- 7 appointed to the commission are required for the commission to
- 8 take action on any measure.
- 9 (h) The members of the commission serve without
- 10 compensation.
- 11 Sec. 5. The commission has the following purposes and duties:
- 12 (1) Plan and develop activities appropriate to commemorate
- 13 Indiana's statehood.
- 14 (2) Encourage private organizations and local governments to
- 15 organize and participate in activities that highlight the
- 16 bicentennial.
- 17 (3) Help coordinate and promote bicentennial activities
- 18 throughout Indiana.
- 19 Sec. 5. This chapter expires June 30, 2017.
- 20 SECTION 2. An emergency is declared for this act.
