DIGEST OF SB 616 (Updated February 20, 2013 6:45 pm - DI 104)

Citations Affected: Noncode.

Synopsis: Study of electronic medical records. Requires the health finance commission to study during the 2013 legislative interim the coordination and efficiency of the collection, maintenance, sharing, and use of electronic health data in Indiana.

Effective: July 1, 2013.

(b) During the 2013 legislative interim, the commission shall study:".

Page 1, delete lines 10 through 17, begin a new paragraph and insert:

"(c) This SECTION expires December 31, 2013."

Delete page 2.
