

COMMITTEE REPORT

MADAM PRESIDENT:

The Senate Committee on Health and Provider Services, to which was referred House Bill No. 1099, has had the same under consideration and begs leave to report the same back to the Senate with the recommendation that said bill be AMENDED as follows:

- 1 Page 5, between lines 36 and 37, begin a new line single block
2 indented and insert:
3 **"(4) For the first year in which a physician assistant obtains**
4 **authority to prescribe a controlled substance under**
5 **IC 25-27.5-5-4, one hundred percent (100%)."**
6 Page 6, after line 4, begin a new paragraph and insert:
7 "SECTION 6. IC 25-27.5-6-4, AS AMENDED BY P.L.197-2011,
8 SECTION 124, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS
9 [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2013]: Sec. 4. (a) A physician supervising a
10 physician assistant must do the following:
11 (1) Be licensed under IC 25-22.5.
12 (2) Register with the board the physician's intent to supervise a
13 physician assistant.
14 (3) Submit a statement to the board that the physician will
15 exercise supervision over the physician assistant in accordance
16 with rules adopted by the board and retain professional and legal
17 responsibility for the care rendered by the physician assistant.
18 (4) Not have a disciplinary action restriction that limits the
19 physician's ability to supervise a physician assistant.
20 (5) Maintain a written agreement with the physician assistant that
21 states the physician will:

- 1 (A) exercise supervision over the physician assistant in
2 accordance with any rules adopted by the board; and
3 (B) retain responsibility for the care rendered by the physician
4 assistant.

5 The agreement must be signed by the physician and physician
6 assistant, updated annually, and made available to the board upon
7 request.

8 **(6) Submit to the board a list of locations that the supervising**
9 **physician and the physician assistant may practice. The board**
10 **may request additional information concerning the practice**
11 **locations to assist the board with considering the written**
12 **agreement described in subdivision (5).**

13 (b) Except as provided in this section, this chapter may not be
14 construed to limit the employment arrangement with a supervising
15 physician under this chapter."

16 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
