

COMMITTEE REPORT

MADAM PRESIDENT:

The Senate Committee on Homeland Security, Transportation and Veterans Affairs, to which was referred House Bill No. 1481, has had the same under consideration and begs leave to report the same back to the Senate with the recommendation that said bill be AMENDED as follows:

- 1 Page 1, line 17, after "but" delete "weighs" and insert "**weigh**".
- 2 Page 3, line 4, after "weight" insert "**of the vehicle**".
- 3 Page 3, line 4, delete "of the".
- 4 Page 3, line 5, delete "vehicle".
- 5 Page 3, line 12, delete "of" and insert "**for**".
- 6 Page 3, line 23, delete "of" and insert "**for**".
- 7 Page 4, line 31, after "expires" delete "of" and insert "**on**".
- 8 Page 5, line 3, after "mile." insert "**The annual fee charged for a**
- 9 **permit issued under IC 9-20-6-2.5 may not exceed four hundred**
- 10 **seventy dollars (\$470).**".
- 11 Page 5, line 15, after "of" insert "**permits for**".
- 12 Page 5, line 17, after "of" insert "**permits for**".
- 13 Page 5, line 18, after "of" insert "**permits for**".
- 14 Page 5, line 20, delete "outlined" and insert "**provided for**".
- 15 Page 5, between lines 21 and 22, begin a new paragraph and insert:
- 16 "**(c) Not later than December 31, 2014, the department shall**
- 17 **study the impact of overweight divisible loads on the following:**
- 18 (1) **Road and bridge degradation.**
- 19 (2) **Alternate modes of transportation.**
- 20 (3) **Indiana's economy and job growth.**
- 21 (4) **Indiana's business and economic competitiveness relative**

1 **to other midwestern states.**
2 **The department shall consider the results of the study in adopting**
3 **rules under subsection (a) to establish fee structures. Upon**
4 **concluding the study, the department shall report the results of the**
5 **study to the general assembly in an electronic format under**
6 **IC 5-14-6."**
