

# COMMITTEE REPORT

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## MADAM PRESIDENT:

The Senate Committee on Rules and Legislative Procedure, to which was referred Senate Bill No. 413, has had the same under consideration and begs leave to report the same back to the Senate with the recommendation that said bill be AMENDED as follows:

- 1 Delete the title and insert the following:  
2 A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning  
3 human services.  
4 Delete everything after the enacting clause and insert the  
5 following:  
6 SECTION 1. IC 12-13-14-4.5, AS AMENDED BY P.L.3-2012,  
7 SECTION 2, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE  
8 JULY 1, 2013]: Sec. 4.5. (a) Except as provided in this section, the  
9 division may distribute cash assistance benefits to a person who is  
10 eligible for assistance under the Title IV-A assistance program though  
11 an automated teller machine or a point of sale terminal that is  
12 connected to the EBT system.  
13 (b) The following establishments shall post a sign next to each  
14 automated teller machine or point of sale terminal located on the  
15 premises informing a potential user that the automated teller machine  
16 or point of sale terminal may not be used to receive cash assistance  
17 benefits under the Title IV-A assistance program:  
18 (1) A horse racing establishment:  
19 (A) where the pari-mutuel system of wagering is authorized;  
20 and  
21 (B) for which a permit is required under IC 4-31-5.  
22 (2) A satellite facility:  
23 (A) where wagering on horse racing is conducted; and  
24 (B) for which a license is required under IC 4-31-5.5.  
25 (3) An allowable event required to be licensed by the Indiana  
26 gaming commission under IC 4-32.2.

- 1 (4) A riverboat or other facility required to be licensed by the  
 2 Indiana gaming commission under IC 4-33.  
 3 (5) A store or other establishment:  
 4 (A) where the primary business is the sale of firearms (as  
 5 defined in IC 35-47-1-5); and  
 6 (B) that sells handguns for which a license to sell handguns  
 7 is required under IC 35-47-2.  
 8 (6) A store or other establishment where the primary business is  
 9 the sale of alcoholic beverages for which a permit is required  
 10 under IC 7.1-3.  
 11 (7) An adult entertainment establishment.  
 12 (c) An:  
 13 (1) establishment that does not post the sign required under  
 14 subsection (b); or  
 15 (2) individual who attempts to use an automated teller machine  
 16 or point of sale terminal with a sign posted as required under  
 17 subsection (b) to access cash assistance benefits under the Title  
 18 IV-A assistance program in violation of subsection (b);  
 19 commits a Class C misdemeanor.  
 20 **(d) The owner, vendor, or third party processor of an**  
 21 **automated teller machine or point of sale terminal shall disable or**  
 22 **have disabled access to electronic cash assistance benefits in a**  
 23 **location described in subsection (b) unless the location has been**  
 24 **approved by the federal Food and Nutrition Services. The division**  
 25 **shall provide assistance to an owner, vendor, or third party**  
 26 **processor under this subsection. A person that violates this**  
 27 **subsection commits a Class B infraction.**  
 28 ~~(d)~~ (e) The division shall adopt rules under IC 4-22-2 to carry out  
 29 this section.  
 (Reference is to SB 413 as introduced.)
