

COMMITTEE REPORT

MADAM PRESIDENT:

The Senate Committee on Appropriations, to which was referred House Bill No. 1483, has had the same under consideration and begs leave to report the same back to the Senate with the recommendation that said bill be AMENDED as follows:

- 1 Page 2, between lines 18 and 19, begin a new paragraph and insert:
2 "SECTION 5. IC 12-13-14-4.5, AS AMENDED BY P.L.3-2012,
3 SECTION 2, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
4 JULY 1, 2013]: Sec. 4.5. (a) Except as provided in this section, the
5 division may distribute cash assistance benefits to a person who is
6 eligible for assistance under the Title IV-A assistance program though
7 an automated teller machine or a point of sale terminal that is
8 connected to the EBT system.
9 (b) The following establishments shall post a sign next to each
10 automated teller machine or point of sale terminal located on the
11 premises informing a potential user that the automated teller machine
12 or point of sale terminal may not be used to receive cash assistance
13 benefits under the Title IV-A assistance program:
14 (1) A horse racing establishment:
15 (A) where the pari-mutuel system of wagering is authorized;
16 and
17 (B) for which a permit is required under IC 4-31-5.
18 (2) A satellite facility:
19 (A) where wagering on horse racing is conducted; and
20 (B) for which a license is required under IC 4-31-5.5.
21 (3) An allowable event required to be licensed by the Indiana

- 1 gaming commission under IC 4-32.2.
- 2 (4) A riverboat or other facility required to be licensed by the
- 3 Indiana gaming commission under IC 4-33.
- 4 (5) A store or other establishment:
- 5 (A) where the primary business is the sale of firearms (as
- 6 defined in IC 35-47-1-5); and
- 7 (B) that sells handguns for which a license to sell handguns is
- 8 required under IC 35-47-2.
- 9 (6) A store or other establishment where the primary business is
- 10 the sale of alcoholic beverages for which a permit is required
- 11 under IC 7.1-3.
- 12 (7) An adult entertainment establishment.
- 13 (c) An:
- 14 (1) establishment that does not post the sign required under
- 15 subsection (b); or
- 16 (2) individual who attempts to use an automated teller machine or
- 17 point of sale terminal with a sign posted as required under
- 18 subsection (b) to access cash assistance benefits under the Title
- 19 IV-A assistance program in violation of subsection (b);
- 20 commits a Class C misdemeanor.
- 21 **(d) The owner, vendor, or third party processor of an**
- 22 **automated teller machine or point of sale terminal shall disable or**
- 23 **have disabled access to electronic cash assistance benefits in a**
- 24 **location described in subsection (b) unless the location has been**
- 25 **approved by the federal Food and Nutrition Services. The division**
- 26 **shall provide assistance to an owner, vendor, or third party**
- 27 **processor under this subsection. A person that violates this**
- 28 **subsection commits a Class B infraction.**
- 29 ~~(e)~~ (e) The division shall adopt rules under IC 4-22-2 to carry out
- 30 this section."
- 31 Page 5, line 7, delete "The" and insert "**Except as provided in**
- 32 **subdivision (3), the**".
- 33 Page 5, line 7, delete "permanently".
- 34 Page 5, line 9, delete "A" and insert "**Except as provided in**
- 35 **subdivision (3), a**".
- 36 Page 5, between lines 11 and 12, begin a new line block indented
- 37 and insert:
- 38 **"(3) After becoming ineligible under subdivision (1) and (2),**
- 39 **an individual may establish eligibility to receive TANF,**
- 40 **including eligibility for a child on whose behalf the individual**
- 41 **would receive TANF, if the individual satisfies the following**
- 42 **requirements:**

- 1 **(A) At the time the individual reapplies to receive TANF,**
2 **the individual provides evidence that the individual has**
3 **completed a drug treatment program.**
4 **(B) The individual tests negative in two (2) consecutive**
5 **drug tests. The office of the secretary shall administer the**
6 **first drug test to the individual at the time of the TANF**
7 **reapplication and the second drug test at least twenty (20)**
8 **days and not more than thirty (30) days after the date of**
9 **the first drug test."**
10 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
