

# COMMITTEE REPORT

## MADAM PRESIDENT:

**The Senate Committee on Judiciary, to which was referred Senate Bill No. 85, has had the same under consideration and begs leave to report the same back to the Senate with the recommendation that said bill be AMENDED as follows:**

- 1           Page 37, between lines 32 and 33, begin a new paragraph and insert:  
2           "SECTION 33. IC 9-13-2-92, AS AMENDED BY P.L.114-2012,  
3           SECTION 19, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE  
4           UPON PASSAGE]: Sec. 92. (a) "Law enforcement officer", except as  
5           provided in subsection (b), includes the following:  
6           (1) A state police officer.  
7           (2) A city, town, or county police officer.  
8           (3) A sheriff.  
9           (4) A county coroner.  
10           (5) A conservation officer.  
11           (6) An individual assigned as a motor carrier inspector under  
12           IC 10-11-2-26(a).  
13           (7) A member of a consolidated law enforcement department  
14           established under IC 36-3-1-5.1.  
15           (8) An excise police officer of the alcohol and tobacco  
16           commission.  
17           **(9) A gaming control officer employed by the gaming control**  
18           **division under IC 4-33-20.**  
19           (b) "Law enforcement officer", for purposes of IC 9-30-6 and  
20           IC 9-30-7, has the meaning set forth in IC 35-31.5-2-185.

1 SECTION 34. IC 9-13-2-127, AS AMENDED BY P.L.94-2006,  
 2 SECTION 3, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE  
 3 UPON PASSAGE]: Sec. 127. (a) "Police officer" means, except as  
 4 provided in subsection (b), the following:

- 5 (1) A regular member of the state police department.
- 6 (2) A regular member of a city or town police department.
- 7 (3) A town marshal or town marshal deputy.
- 8 (4) A regular member of a county sheriff's department.
- 9 (5) A conservation officer of the department of natural resources.
- 10 (6) An individual assigned as a motor carrier inspector under
- 11 IC 10-11-2-26(a).
- 12 (7) An excise police officer of the alcohol and tobacco
- 13 commission.

14 **(8) A gaming control officer employed by the gaming control**  
 15 **division under IC 4-33-20.**

16 (b) "Police officer", for purposes of IC 9-21, means an officer  
 17 authorized to direct or regulate traffic or to make arrests for violations  
 18 of traffic regulations."

19 Page 48, between lines 17 and 18, begin a new paragraph and insert:

 21 SECTION 82, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE  
 22 UPON PASSAGE]: Sec. 69. (a) "Division", except as provided in  
 23 subsections (b) and (c), refers to any of the following:

- 25 established by IC 12-9-1-1.
- 26 (2) The division of aging established by IC 12-9.1-1-1.

- 27 refers to the division whose director has administrative control of and
- 28 responsibility for the appropriate state institution."
- 29 Page 91, line 22, strike "or".
- 30 Page 91, line 24, delete "." and insert "; **or**".
- 31 Page 91, between lines 24 and 25, begin a new line block indented
- 32 and insert:

- 1           **"(7) a gaming control officer employed by the gaming control**
- 2           **division under IC 4-33-20."**
- 3           Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.  
(Reference is to SB 85 as introduced.)

**and when so amended that said bill do pass.**
