

COMMITTEE REPORT

MADAM PRESIDENT:

The Senate Committee on Rules and Legislative Procedure, to which was referred Senate Bill No. 209, has had the same under consideration and begs leave to report the same back to the Senate with the recommendation that said bill be AMENDED as follows:

- 1 Delete everything after the enacting clause and insert the
2 following:
3 SECTION 1. IC 21-18-9-5, AS AMENDED BY P.L.169-2011,
4 SECTION 21, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
5 JULY 1, 2013]: Sec. 5. **(a)** The commission may approve or disapprove
6 the:
7 (1) establishment of any new branches, regional or other
8 campuses, or extension centers;
9 (2) establishment of any new college or school; or
10 (3) offering on any campus of any:
11 (A) additional associate, baccalaureate, or graduate degree;
12 or
13 (B) additional program leading to a certificate or other
14 indication of accomplishment.
15 **(b) The commission shall approve the establishment of not
16 more than six (6) graduate degree programs, which may include
17 doctoral degree programs, at the Indiana University—Purdue
18 University Fort Wayne campus. Each program approved under
19 this subsection must be aligned with an industry that is identified
20 as a target industry for regional economic development. Total
21 enrollment in the programs may not exceed ninety-six (96) students
22 each academic year.**
(Reference is to SB 209 as introduced.)
